



Climate Change Puts Wild Coffee Species at Risk



Climate change and deforestation are putting more than half the

risk of extinction, including the popular commercial coffees – Arabica and Robusta. scientists warned on Wednesday. Research published by experts at Britain's Royal Botanic Gardens at Kew found that current conservation measures for wild coffee species are not enough to protect their longterm future. Aaron Davis, head of coffee research at Kew, who co-led the work, said that among coffee species threatened with extinction are some that could be used to breed and develop the coffees of the future, including some that have resistance to disease and that can withstand worsening cli-

Mumbai: The Bombay High Court on Thursday has adjourned the hearing in the writ petition filed by Kotak Mahindra Bank against the Reserve Bank of India to March 12 after RBI's counsel Venkatesh Dhond asked for more time to file their affidavit response in reply to

the bank's writ petition. Kotak had moved the Bombay High Court against RBI's direction to dilute promoter shareholding that had disallowed the use of preference shares to reduce promoter shareholding in India's second most valuable private lender. Harish Salve is representing Kotak Bank in the matter. The Reserve Bank of India is waiting for Bombay High Court's ruling on promoter Uday Kotak reducing his stake in Kotak Mahindra

Bank to 20%. "The RBI, represented by senior counsel Venkatesh Dhodh, requested for some more time to file their affidavit in reply to the writ petition filed by Kotak Mahindra Bank," said a person in know of the develop-

Kotak's personal shareholding stood at 29.73% at the end of September, compared with 31.77% at the end of March 2017, according to information on the BSE website. Under the RBI guidelines for new banks, the promoters of Kotak Mahindra had to reduce their holding to 20% by December 2018.

SBI Raises \$1.25b via Dollar Bond Sale

Mumbai: The country's largest lender State Bank of India has raised a total of \$1.25 billion in its largest funding deal in almost five years as it arms itself for demand for dollar funds from companies in the

new year. SBI raised \$1.25 billion in a dual bond sale which included a threeyear note and a five-year bond to investors across the globe. Strong demand ensured that the bank received total bids worth \$4 billion allowing the bank to raise money at a tighter yield than what bankers had indicated.

"This is the largest US dollar bond issuance by SBI after April 2014 denoting the strong investor followingforthe credit," said Shashank Joshi, head global corporate banking at MUFG. "The deal saw the highest participation for any SBI

RBI's Revised ECB Norms may Open Funding Doors for Firms

Mumbai: Easier norms for companies wanting to raise money through external commercial borrowings (ECBs) is set to open the door for a lot of Indian entities, especially NBFCs, to borrow from abroad and at a lower cost.

Late on Wednesday evening, the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) reduced the ECB maturity tenor, increased borrowing limits and removed qualification restrictions for companies wanting to borrow funds from abroad, _____ boosting the chances of these companies to borrow

from overseas. Harry Parikh, associate partner, transaction tax services, BDO India, said the liberalised norms open up the opportunity for companies from the service sector as well as limited liability partnerships

Further, all eligible borrowers can now get funds up to \$750 million or equiva-

year under the auto-

matic route, replacing the

existing sector-wise limits. It also set the minimum average maturity period at three years for all ECBs regardless of the amount. Previously, companies could only borrow up to \$50 million for three years. For funds beyond \$50 million, companies had to borrow for at least five-year maturity.

"Besides the easier borrowing limit, the new norms also allow lenders from any Financial Access Task Force (FATF)compliant entity as a recognised lender. This increases options for the borrowers. It has been also clarified that housing companies just need to have an affordable housing project and to access funds from abroad. The only thing that needs clarification is whether overseas borrowings can be used to pay back rupee loans," said Hitendra Dave, head, global banking and markets at HSBC India.

It is expected that even lower rated companies will seriously look at ECB as a funding option after the new guidelines.

"The factors supporting the price rise include end of the Bhavantar scheme of Madhya Pradesh on January 19, expectations of increase in export of oilmeal to Iran and holding of soyabeans by the trading community," Jain said.

Though the prices have moved up, small farmers from states like Maharashtra will not benefit after the peak arrival season as they have sold their produce at lower than the minimum support price of ₹3,390

lading is submitted. "The situation is contrary to previous years when exporters were extended advance payments based on export history and export orders," said Amit Migla ni, the managing director of rice exporter Lekh Raj Narender

Kumar. This is because Iran has overhauled its payment mechanism to check misuse of subsidy on foodgrain by domestic importers who wrongly claim benefit on goods other than basmati, sources in the trade said.

However, the situation is expected to improve, driving exports and strengthening prices from the current range of \$1,050-1,200 (₹74,550-85,200) per tonne, traders said.
