

ONGC Videsh Makes Major Oil Discovery in Columbia

Our Bureau

New Delhi: ONGC Videsh (OVL) has made a significant discovery of oil in its onshore block CPO-5 in Columbia, the company said in a statement.

OVL, the overseas arm of ONGC, is the operator of the block and holds 70% interest. Petrodorado South America SA (PDASA) has the balance 30% interest in the block.

"The (Indico-1) well was successfully logged and found to have 284 feet of

gross thickness and 241 feet net pay, single hydrodynamically connected reservoir with no indication of oil-water contact," the company said.

Last year, OVL had discovered commercial oil in the well Mariposa-1, which is about 6.5 km from Indico-1, and the continuation of same play is confirmed in the recent well, OVL said.

The firm plans to drill more exploratory wells for further evaluation. OVL also plans to acquire additional 3D seismic data to map more drillable prospects in the other sectors of the block.

GUIDELINES OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT MINISTRY

Buildings Should Have 20% Parking Space for EV Charging

NEW RULES Space for kiosks in eateries; buildings to have extra power load

New Delhi: Residential and commercial complexes will have to allot 20% of their parking space for electric vehicle charging facilities, while eateries will have to reserve space for kiosks as per the new guidelines of the housing and urban development ministry.

The department of town and country planning under the ministry has issued guidelines to provide for electric vehicle charging infrastructure through addendum to Model Building Bye-Laws, 2016 and Urban and Regional Development Plan Formulation and Implementation Guidelines, 2014.

The guidelines on charging infrastructure mandate provisions in various buildings.

"Based on the occupancy pattern and the total parking provisions in the premises of the various building types, charging infrastructures shall be provided only for electric vehicles, which is currently assumed to be 20% of all 'vehicle holding capacity' at the premise. Additionally, the building premises have to have an additional power load, equivalent to power of all the charging points operated simultaneously," the guidelines said.

For residential and institutional buildings, they recommend that the metering and payment be linked with the house owner's monthly maintenance bills with metered units credited to their smart card that is plugged during charging. The buildings should provide open metering and on-spot payment options for visitors.

The tariff for supply of electricity shall not be more than the average cost of supply plus 15%

"Charging bays shall be planned currently at 20% capacity of all vehicles including two-wheelers and cars," the guidelines said.

They also provide for enhanced power load for each such building type by the power distribution company.

"Connectivity regulations and safety norms will be the key for implementation of electric vehicle charging infrastructures both at individual and public premises," said Alekhya Datta, fellow and area convenor, electricity and fuels division, TERI.

The power ministry last month issued guidelines for charging infrastructure under which it has asked public charging stations to install both Japanese and European

charging platforms. The guidelines specify technical parameters for slow and fast varieties of CCS, CHADEMO and Bharat platforms. CHADEMO is a charging platform used by Japanese car makers like Suzuki and Toyota, while Combined Charging System (CCS) is promoted by 15 out of 20 major OEMs across the globe.

The guidelines require one charging station to be set up every three km in cities and every 25 km on both sides of highways. The tariff for supply of electricity to electric vehicle public charging station shall not be more than the average cost of supply plus 15%, the guidelines said. States will fix ceiling on service charges of the public charging stations.

The power ministry early last year issued a notification clarifying that setting up charging stations for electric vehicles will not require a separate licence under the Electricity Act of 2003.

Try Diverting Gas from Non-Core Sectors to Stuck Power Units: Panel

New Delhi: The government should explore diverting domestic gas allocation from non-core sectors to stranded gas-based power plants, a parliamentary panel has suggested, while asking the government to spell out the action taken against those responsible for the "gross miscalculation" of gas availability in KG D6.

Calling for cost moderation of regassified liquefied natural gas (RLNG), the panel has also asked the government to rethink its plan of free market pricing of natural gas, saying it will be counter-productive and not in the public interest.

KG D6 OUTPUT WAS expected to be about 80 MMSCMD by 2009-end. However, output fell to 5.5 MMSCMD in 2017-18, and today the production is as good as nil, the House panel said

The oil ministry's proposal for removal of power sector from priority allocation should also be reconsidered and instead the government should restart its e-bid RLNG scheme to support these stranded plants with necessary exemptions, waivers and desired modifications, said the standing committee on energy in its report on stressed/non-performing assets in gas-based power plants.

The financial support or subsidies required for the scheme may be sourced from Power System Development Fund, National Clean Energy Fund or budgetary grants for which the power ministry should pursue with the finance ministry, it said.

The parliamentary panel has proposed that the government should hand-hold these stranded gas-based power plants and provide them requisite support to revive them. The committee said it is dismayed to note that State Bank of India, the largest lender in the country, does not have any solution regarding these stranded plants and wants to write off the investment made in these gas-based plants.

"The ministry of petroleum & natural gas should come out with the reasons, in lucid terms, for zero production of gas from KG D6 against the estimated production of 80 MMSCMD that was envisaged earlier and the steps taken by the government against those who are responsible for this gross miscalculation, which has put the reliability of the ministry at stake," the panel said.

Of the total 24,867 MW gas-based power generation capacity, 14,305 MW is stranded due to shortage of domestic gas supply. The peak flow of gas from KG D6 was expected to be about 80 MMSCMD by the end of 2009 and rise further in subsequent years. But the production started declining from 55.35 MMSCMD in 2010-11 to 5.5 MMSCMD in 2017-18, and today, the production is as good as nil, the panel said.
