IndiGo says it will cancel 30 flights/day till March-end

Mumbai: Faced with acute pilot shortage, low-cost airline IndiGo cancelled nearly 50 flights across the country on Wednesday. The country's largest airline for domestic operations has now announced a curtailed schedule for February and March, with about 30 flights cancellations planned per day. The cancellations, which will hit over 2.3 lakh, began last week and are the worst ever operational disruptions that the 12-year old carrier has ever faced. "These 30 flights represent 2% of IndiGo's flights," the airline said.

On Wednesday, flights to/from Bengaluru, Hyderabad, Chennai and Kolkata accounted for nearly half of all cancellations. Mumbai cancellations included 6E 236 to Bengaluru, 6E 3834 to Chennai and in the arrivals category, 6E 831 from Guwahati, 6E 654 from Chennai and 6E 318 from Kolkata.

Those hit from Delhi were 6E 774 to Nagpur, 6E 2131 to Bengaluru and in the arrivals category, 6E 766 from Hyderabad, 6E 2652 and 6E 2622 from Chennai.

Sources said that the airline is currently in the process of recruiting foreign pilots on contract to close the gap. "IndiGo has been putting in applications to the Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) to bring in foreign pilots under FTA (Foreign Aircrew Temporary Authorisation)," said a DGCA source.

Raj gives Gujjars 5% job, education quota

Jaipur: In the backdrop of the ongoing Gujjar agitation, the Rajasthan assembly passed a bill to give a separate 5% quota in jobs and educational institutions to Gujjars and four other communities by clubbing them as "more backward class" (MBC) within the OBC (other backward class).

The bill also provides for increasing the income limit for defining creamy layer in OBC from Rs 2.5 lakh to Rs 8 lakh per annum. Not just the 'Gujjar quota', the Assembly on Wednesday also gave its nod for 10% EWS (economically weaker section) quota approved by the Centre, thereby taking the total reservation in Rajasthan to 64%. Crorepatis can avail EWS quota in Haryana

Chandigarh: Even crorepatis — individuals or a family having immovable property worth Rs 1 crore — will be considered for the economically weaker section (EWS) quota in Haryana. However, if the value of the assets is even one paisa above Rs 1 crore, the family will not make the cut.

The criteria to provide 10% quota under the newly-carved EWS category was approved on Wednesday by the Haryana cabinet at its meeting in Chandigarh. The cabinet, headed by CM Manohar Lal Khattar, decided to grant reservation to the extent of 10% each to EWS in direct recruitment to Group A, B, C and D post in all departments, boards,

corporations and local bodies of the state government and for admission to all government or government-aided educational institutions.

As per the approved criteria, a family for this purpose would include the person who seeks benefit of reservation, his/her parents, spouse and children and siblings aged below 18.

14 AMU students charged with sedition

Agra: Fourteen students of the Aligarh Muslim University (AMU) have been charged with sedition, among other things, after they allegedly "assaulted" a TV crew and some members of the BJP youth wing on Tuesday.

It all started after some students objected to the proposed visit of All India Majlis-e-Ittehadul Muslimeen leader Asaduddin Owaisi to the campus. SSP (Aligarh) Aakash Kulhari told TOI on Wednesday that two separate FIRs were filed on the basis of complaints given by the TV journalists and BJP youth wing leader Mukesh Lodhi. Provisions of the sedition law was invoked on the complaint of assault by Lodhi.

Another complaint was filed by a reporter with the TV station who had gone to the campus for a story, alleging that the AMU security officer and students "misbehaved" with her and her colleagues and snatched their camera.

University spokesperson Shafiq Kidwai said the TV journalists had not sought any permission to enter the campus. "When some students objected to her presence at the proctor's office, the camera person misbehaved with the varsity staff. The team was then escorted out of the campus. The AMU administration has also filed a police complaint."

The students' union said the sedition charges were "frivolous and based on falsehood and fraud".

Coming soon: Kalashnikovs made in Amethi

New Delhi: The iconic Kalashnikov rifles will now be made in India. The government has cleared a project to manufacture around 7.50 lakh assault rifles in a joint venture with Russia at the ordnance factory at Korwa, which falls in the Amethi constituency of Congress president Rahul Gandhi.

Sources said an inter-governmental agreement to manufacture the 7.62x39 mm caliber AK-203 guns, which are a derivative of the famous AK-47 rifle, is likely to be inked on February 15. In the run-up to the Lok Sabha polls, Prime Minister Narendra Modi is slated to inaugurate the project at Korwa on February 28. "It has been decided that a serving Major General from the Army will head the Korwa factory for effective implementation of the AK-203 rifle project, which could eventually be worth over Rs 12,000 crore. The JV will also seek to export the rifles to other countries, mutually approved by India and Russia, much like jointly-developed BrahMos supersonic cruise missiles," said a source.

This comes after the government told Russia that its firm Kalashnikov Concern would have to tie-up with

state-run Ordnance Factory Board (OFB), instead of its earlier proposal for a JV with the Adani Group, as was reported by TOI last year.

The government, of course, is wary about any blowback in the rifle project in the backdrop of the Congress levelling charges of "crony capitalism" in the way Anil Ambani's Reliance Defence was chosen as one of the main offsets partner of Dassault Aviation in the Rs 59,000 crore contract for 36 French Rafale fighters.

The AK-203 rifle project will be a boost for the over 14-lakh strong armed forces, which have been demanding new assault rifles for well over a decade to replace the existing glitch-prone 5.56mm INSAS (Indian small arms system) rifles. India on Tuesday had also inked a Rs 647 crore contract for a limited number of 72,400 new 7.62x51mm assault rifles from the US firm SIG Sauer under the fast-track procurement (FTP) route for its frontline soldiers deployed on the borders with China and Pakistan. "The delivery of these rifles, which have a longer kill range, will be completed within a year. The AK-203 rifles, in turn, will equip all other soldiers," said an official.

Arjuna awardee gets 12 yrs' jail in 3 drug cases

Patiala: Arjuna Award-winning wrestler Jagdish Singh alias Bhola, who now runs a Rs 6,000 crore international synthetic drug racket, was convicted and handed down 12-, 10- and two-year concurrent jail sentences on Wednesday by a CBI court in Mohali.

He has been sentenced in three of the seven cases linked to the 2013 multi-crore drugs racket.

He was sentenced to imprisonment for 12, 10 and two years. He was convicted in three cases and acquitted in four. Anoop Singh Khalon and industrialist Jagjit Singh Chahal were also convicted.

Special CBI judge NS Gill convicted 21 others with Bhola in five of the seven cases registered against them between 2013 and 2017. They had been charged under sections of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act, 1985. In one case, Bhola was implicated for transport of a huge quantity of drugs along with Rs 8.94,800 in cash and some foreign currency in March 2013. He was named in several other cases related to transport of drugs during the same year. He has been convicted for three such cases.

In a first, TN lawyer obtains 'no caste, religion' certificate

Vellore: This is to certify that she does not belong to any caste or religion. A tahsildar in Vellore district in Tamil Nadu issued this certificate to a woman lawyer A Snegha Parthibaraja, who later claimed that she was the first Indian to obtain such an official certificate.

When TOI contacted Tirupattur sub-collector Priyanka Pankajam refused to quote any rule but said it was an "exceptional case".

Snegha told TOI that despite court directives and government orders clarifying that no one could be compelled to mention caste in certificates, schools made students mention their caste and community names in their school certificates. In reality, such directives are a big failure, she said.

In some cases even if the parents manage to obtain no-caste-no-religion certificates, their applications under the general category get rejected. She said: "Being an advocate I wanted to break this barrier. As a result of my nine-year struggle and regular follow up on the last application submitted in May 2017, the government has now issued the no-caste-no-religion certificate."
