Mob of 1,000 lynches two in Meghalaya

Shillong: Two persons were lynched by an angry mob in Meghalaya's West Garo Hills district and another was injured, police said on Friday.

The incident took place at Chanangpara village after the locals were alerted about the suspicious movement of the trio in their car, they said.

A mob of over a 1,000 people stopped the car and found weapons — a dagger and rods — inside the trunk. They then fatally attacked the occupants of the car leaving two of them dead and one seriously wounded, according to eyewitnesses.

While the victims ran to take shelter in a house, the crowd barged in and dragged them out before thrashing them. One Mokhibul Akond died on the spot while Mokseng Marak was declared brought dead at the hospital.

Fresh case of rioting against 4 from AMU

Agra: A day after Aligarh police chief said that no prima facie evidence had been found thus far to support sedition charges against 14 Aligarh Muslim University (AMU) students, another case of rioting and attempt to murder was filed against four varsity students late on Thursday night.

The FIR was registered on a complaint of BJP's Aligarh unit media in-charge Nishit Sharma, who alleged that AMU students' union secretary Huzaifa Amir, former union secretary Nadeem Ansari and a few others had assaulted him and his associate Shaileendra Singh. Though Sharma alleged the accused were also shouting anti-national and pro-Pakistan slogans, local police did not press sedition charges this time.

ADMK, BJP seal seat-sharing deal for LS with 25-15 formula

To Give Seats To Allies From Own Share

Chennai: After months of speculation over an electoral alliance between AIADMK and BJP, the two sides late on Thursday night arrived at a 25-15 formula to share Tamil Nadu's 40 Lok Sabha seats (including the lone Puducherry seat). The two parties agreed to apportion seats to smaller parties from their own share.

A source privy to a meeting CM Edappadi K Palaniswami and deputy CM O Panneerselvam had with Union finance minister Piyush Goyal told TOI that BJP may get eight seats, leaving four

for PMK and three for DMDK. From its 25 seats, AIADMK has to accommodate G K Vaasan's TMC, N Rangaswamy's NRC and K Krishnaswamy's PT. All the small parties, however, may not get to contest.

TOI, on February 4, had reported such an alliance was being formed up. AIADMK ministers P Thangamani and SP Velumani were present at the meeting held at the resi-

dence of industrialist Polachi N Mahalingam in Alwarpet in Chennai. "All parties are on board and we have managed to form a mega alliance, which BJP could not do in 2014," said the source.

"Seats for individual parties will be decided from within the respective quota and a second round of meeting will be held early next week to thrash out minor

differences before a formal announcement. Some of the constituents may not get a seat," said the source.

Insiders said there were lingering issues over getting all the prospective constituents on board. PMK wanted AIADMK to negotiate with it directly, since it has a bigger vote than BJP in Tamil Nadu. BJP leaders, however, feel they can bring around Anbumani Ramadoss to make the formal announcement soon.

There were also differences within AIADMK over alliance partners. Talks picked up after BJP top brass deputed two businessmen from the state to talk to all parties.

While the exact numbers and seats is yet to be worked up, a broad understanding has been reached, a source in AIADMK said.

Liver rushed for recipient by Mumbai train

Mumbai: In the first such instance, a human organ was ferried on a Mumbai local train on Friday for transplant.

A cadaver liver was carried in an ice box from Thane's Jupiter Hospital to Parel's Global Hospital, where the recipient was admitted, in 38 minutes during non-peak hours. The journey was supported by a green corridor created for the ambulance by traffic police personnel in Thane and in Dadar. Central Railway officials admitted it was a challenge but said they would encourage transportation of organs even in future to save lives. The donor's family facilitated the city's 15th organ donation of the year and gave a new lease of life to three people.

The 53-year-old donor had met with an accident on Wednesday. The donor, who worked as a health volunteer, had already pledged his organs.

Bengaluru: Flight Lieutenant Hina Jaiswal "created history" on Friday by becoming the first female flight engineer to be inducted by the Indian Air Force. Hina, who was commissioned in the IAF's engineering branch in 2015, completed her course at the Air Force Station in Yelahanka.

Hailing from Chandigarh, Hina got her BE from Panjab University. She is the only daughter of DK Jaiswal and Anita Jaiswal and describes her achievement as a "dream come true". "Since childhood, she has aspired to don the soldier's uniform and take to the skies. Finally, her dreams have manifested into reality," said a release by the Press Information Bureau.

66 days with 1 mantri, KCR to expand team

Hyderabad: Telangana will finally have a full-fledged cabinet. Bringing down the curtains on 66 days of suspense, CM K Chandrababtu Naidu has decided to expand his two-member team. The muhurat has been set for 11.30 am on February 19. In the December 7 assembly elections last year, TRS had registered a thumping victory.

KCR was sworn in on December 13, making this one of the longest gestation periods between a party winning an assembly election and finally having a full-fledged cabinet. The only other min-



ister who was sworn in with KCR for a second term was Mohammed Mahmood Ali. With the state budget session scheduled from February 22-25, speculation is rife on who would present the budget. Although names of prospective ministers are doing the rounds, there is no clarity on who will be in and who out.

While TRS leaders couldn't put their finger on what held KCR back for so long, sources said he took his time as he wanted to "streamline" departments — more wings under each ministry — so that key ministers could run the state machinery effectively.

Puducherry: CM V Narayanasamy on Friday said the agitation against lieutenant governor Kiran Bedi will continue till February 21, the day she is set to return to Puducherry.

The agitation, against the LG for "stalling" welfare schemes of the Congress government in the UT, entered the third day on Friday. The CM, his cabinet colleagues, and Congress and DMK MLAs have been on a sit-in protest since Wednesday outside Bedi's residence. They have even been spending the nights on the road.

Bedi, who left for Delhi on Thursday, has invited Narayanasamy for a talk on February 21. The CM, who had written to Bedi urging her to fulfill a 39-point charter of demands, said Bedi could resolve all the issues within an hour, but was choosing not to do so.

HC judge elevation: Income rule relaxed for SCs, STs, OBCs

New Delhi: The Supreme Court collegium has relaxed the minimum income criterion of Rs 7 lakh for candidates belonging to SC, ST and OBC communities and for those working for the government as standing or panel counsels for their elevation as high court judges.

The collegium, comprising chief justice Ranjan Gogoi and justices A K Sikri and S A Bobde, took the decision on February 12 and the order was uploaded on the apex court's website on Friday. It also reiterated the recommendation to elevate advocate P V Kunhikrishnan as a Kerala high court judge.

Upload farmers' data by Feb 20, states told

New Delhi: The Centre has written to all states, asking them to be on board to launch its 'assured income support' scheme for farmers simultaneously on February 24 when PM Narendra Modi formally launches it in Gorakhpur.

States and Union Territories have been asked to share with the Centre the data of eligible beneficiaries on the dedicated portal for the scheme at a fast pace so that "substantial entries" are made by February 20.

The scheme (PM-KISAN) will also be simultaneously launched in all Indian Council of Agricultural Re-

search institutions and Krishi Vigyan Kendra across the country," said an official referring to the agriculture ministry's communication.

A note was written to all states and UTs on Thursday. The ministry has target to cover one crore eligible small and marginal farmers

by transferring the first instalment of Rs 2,000 in each of their bank accounts on the day of the national launch of PM-KISAN on February 24. Remaining eligible farmers will get Rs 2,000 each in their bank accounts by March 31.
