Parties seek to save forest voters

BJP, Cong To File Review Pleas In SC

New Delhi: BJP and Congress have asked CMs of states where the parties are in office to file review petitions in the Supreme Court against a recent order directing state governments to evict tribals and other forest dwellers whose ownership claims under the Forest Rights Act have been rejected.

BJP president Amit Shah took to Twitter on Monday to say, "I have spoken to all CMs of BJP-ruled states... The states will be soon filing review petitions and care will be taken to safeguard the rights of our tribals and pre-

vent eviction."

Congress chief Rahul Gandhi too has asked the party's CMs to file a review petition. On Monday, Rahul sent letters to state governments in Chhattisgarh and Madhya Pradesh which have a high proportion of tribal population besides states of Rajasthan, Punjab, Karnataka and Puducherry.

Shah's statement comes at a time when the Centre is facing flak from opposition parties and activists for not doing enough to defend the rights of forest dwellers. Though the ministry of tribal affairs has refuted the charge. clearly the ruling dispensation now feels the need to step

New Delhi: PM Narendra Modi on Monday used the inauguration of the National War Memorial to attack the Nehru-Gandhi family for what he said was criminal negligence of national security and the armed forces while using defence deals as a conduit to make money.

"From Bofors to the (VVIP) helicopter deal, all the investigations have pointed to only one family... Now, these people are trying their best to ensure the Rafale fighters do not arrive in India," he said addressing exservicemen. Noting that his government had fulfilled its promise of constructing the NWM, the PM said the previous Congress governments probably thought it would be better "to forget the martyrs" because "they would gain

membering them". EPFO explores ways to hike pension payout

New Delhi: The Employees' Provident Fund Organisation (EPFO) is looking to make it more attractive for its subscribers to stay invested in its Employees' Pension Scheme (EPS) even as the government decides on raising the minimum pension payment for individuals who are currently entitled to get at least Rs 1,000 a month.

Sources said the retirement savings agency has set up a committee which is looking at multiple options to make EPS more attractive for the subscribers to stay invested even if they switch jobs. "We are seeing if we can offer a choice to put more money into the pension scheme. Also we will see if incentives can be given," said a source.

Employees have to contribute 12% of their basic pay and dearness allowance towards their EPF contribution, with a matching contribution coming from the employer. Out of the employer's contribution, 8.33% goes towards EPS. Anyone who remains a member for 10 years or more is entitled to pension.

"When people switch jobs after two-three years, many of them withdraw their money," said an official. EPFO is looking an 'auto trigger' which will enable an employee changing jobs to shift his PF and pension account to the new employer without opening a fresh account. This will be done using universal account number.

"IL&FS exposure safe": EPFO has asked the 1,374 exempted trusts to share details of their exposure to bonds issued by the IL&FS Group but officials sought to comfort subscribers that their investment is safe. Sources said in case of exempted trusts, the rules mandate that any losses on investment have to be made good by the employer.


Rlys leases out 45 acres of Dharavi land for ₹3,800cr

Mumbai: In a bid to redevelop Asia's largest slum sprawl in Dharavi, Maharashtra government has clinched a deal to take over 45 acres of railway land in central Mumbai on a 99-year lease for Rs 3,800 crore.

Railway minister Piyush Goval, making the announcement on Monday, said the Rail Land Development Authority (RLDA) will hand over 45 acres of "surplus" land to the Dharavi Development Authority (DDA) for the redevelopment." The decision will "help transform the lives of lakhs of Dharavi residents," he added.

Sources said this is a rare instance of railways handing over land for a project to be executed by a state. Governments in the past three

decades have made several attempts to rehabilitate Dharavi's residents. Today, the total cost of the project is estimated at Rs 26,000 crore.

Westernand Central Rail-

ways have two parcels of land abutting Dharavi-one measuring 17 acres and relatively unencumbered; the second of 90 acres has godowns, a scrap yard and encroachments on it. The state had sought the entire 107 acres of land to resettle shan-

ty dwellers in transit camps during redevelopment. The railways has agreed to transfer around 45 acres.

The deal was struck in the face of strong resistance from railway officials, some of whom feared it may engender allegations of graft, besides drawing adverse remarks from the comptroller and auditor general of India for conceding prime land. Also, some of them said surrendering land close to railway tracks may affect future expansion plans.

The deal was sealed after much bargaining. Railway had sought an upfront payment of Rs 1,200 crore of the total Rs 3,800 crore, while the state was willing to pay Rs 800 crore. It was finally settled at Rs 1,000 crore, of which Rs 800 crore will be paid immediately and the balance in six months.
