## Revealed: A ₹300cr Choksi land scam

Diamantaire, Aides Bought 25 Acres For Diamond SEZ That Never Took Off

**Navi Mumbai:** Diamantaire Mehul Choksi's name has cropped up in suspicious land deals dating back to 2008 for a Panvel-based gems and jewellery special economic zone (SEZ) that never got off the ground.

Records show Choksi bought land for a diamond SEZ in his own name and a few of his associates, and not in his company's, in violation of SEZ regulations. Choksi and aides own 25 acres in Panvel worth Rs 300 crore at current market prices.

His company, Gitanjali Gems Ltd (GGL), was to buy the land in two Panvel villages that fell in the green zone then, with the stated purpose of setting up an SEZ. Panvel

tehsildar's office is investigating the case.

Documents, copies of which are with TOI, show that GGL had applied for the SEZ on 25 acres of land before Mani Shankar, the then development commissioner (industries), in Chirvat and Sangurli villages in 2008 under Mum-

bai Tenancy and Agricultural Land Act 1948. The two villages then fell in the green zone.

The order came with three riders. One, GGL had to obtain permission from the planning department and MMRDA to convert the green zone land in the two villages for bona fide industrial use. Accordingly,

GGL had submitted an affidavit. Two, the land was to be purchased within two years, and three put to industrial use within five years from the order date, March 31, 2008. Else, the land owners would have the right to repurchase the land at the same purchase price. The land is yet to be returned to the original owners though.

On May 4, 2017, Vikas Jain, the then development commissioner (industries), cancelled the purchase order, citing that the Central government had withdrawn the permission granted for the SEZ using the sunset clause. GGL twice represented the case before the development commissioner (industries) on April 15 and 24, 2017. Lack of progress

in submissions, though, finally led to cancellation of the land purchase order.

Vinod Lachake, Panvel tehsildar office senior clerk, said, "The SEZ land purchase and cancellation orders have been received from the Raigad collector. Nowhere is GGL mentioned or represented by Choksi in the 7/12 land extracts." A 7/12 document is an extract from the land register which gives details about a plot.

Activist Santosh Thakur said, "The green zone villages were denotified around 2012." RTI activist Bharat Jadhav said, "People do not even know that a gems SEZ was to come up here. Their land were purchased at throwaway prices with agents as middlemen."

## Going abroad for studies? You may've to register with govt

**New Delhi:** Indian students looking to study abroad may soon have to register with the government before they take that flight to their destination of choice for higher studies. The proposal is a part of the draft Emigration Bill 2019 which the ministry of external affairs (MEA) will introduce in Parliament once it has completed the process of feedback which it is seeking from the public.

Official sources said though the bill is out in the public domain since January 9, it is not yet final and, depending upon public feedback, several changes could be made. The process of registration/intimation by students is unlikely to be cumbersome as it will be done online, said officials.

"The Bill makes mandatory registration/intimation of all categories of Indian nationals proceeding for overseas employment as well as students pursuing studies abroad. Registration/intimation is proposed to be technology/digital platform driven so as to keep emigration a swift, efficient and hassle-free process," says the proposed bill, adding that necessary provisions have been incorporated to exempt certain categories in this regard on a need basis.

India had this year made similar registration mandatory for those seeking work in 18 countries — UAE, Afghanistan, Bahrain, Indonesia, Iraq, Jordan, Kuwait,

Lebanon, Libya, Malaysia, Oman, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, Sudan, South Sudan, Syria, Thailand, and Yemen.

According to the government, mandatory registration/intimation by students and Indian nationals working abroad are aimed at assisting them in times of distress and emergency and putting in place an "effective emigration management framework". The bill, it says, aims at optimum utilisation of existing resources and manpower through creating new elaborate structures. The bill further makes mandatory registration of recruitment and student enrolment agencies and also includes provision for their rating. "Sub-agents working with recruitment agencies have also been brought under the ambit of proposed bill," it says.

The government is looking to create with the bill an Emigration Management Authority (EMA). It proposes that the EMA be led by a secretary-level officer from MEA, the nodal ministry for all emigration related matters, and have representatives also from MHA and HRD ministries.

## Officer under CBI lens for Bofors parts found dead

**Bhopal/Jabalpur:** A junior works manager of Gun Carriage Factory (GCF) Jabalpur; who was missing since January 17, was found dead in a deserted area of the city on Tuesday.

Sarada Charan Khatua had vanished a week after being questioned by CBI in connection with the alleged supply and use of Chinese parts in indigenous Bofors guns. His badly decomposed body was found in a deserted region in Sector 2 near the ordnance factory.

It's strange that the body lay rotting and no one noticed despite a missing person's complaint being active for 19 days. A local resident grew suspicious about Khatua's abandoned car on Tuesday and called police, who then found the body.

Khatua's family members allege he was murdered as part of a conspiracy, but police believe he committed suicide. Khatua's wife Mousumi is in shock and in no condition to speak. Her brother Manas Behera, a Supreme Court advocate, said: "He has been murdered by the kingpin of the syndicate. His head has been mutilated. Some people, who were threatening my sister, should be suspended. I have tweeted to PMO, seeking immediate intervention."

Behera accused a senior GCF officer of harassing Khatua and pushing him into severe depression. Jabalpur SP Amit Kumar told TOI that they have sent the body for postmortem. "We found a blade near the spot and it seems he committed suicide," he said.

## Twitter execs to face House panel for 'bias'

**New Delhi:** Twitter India has been called before Parliament's standing committee on information technology in what is being seen as a response to concerns over fake news and representations that the platform has been proactive in shutting down pro-BJP and right-wing handles.

The complaint of political bias against Twitter India has been aired by several BJP and right-wing social media users with Delhi BJP spokesperson Tajinder Bagga organising a protest against the platform. Right-wing handles have accused Twitter India officials of bias against PM Narendra Modi, digging out tweets that they say display an anti-BJP orientation.



Committee sources said the panel will examine a range of issues, including the problems of fake news, particularly in the run-up to Lok Sabha elections. BJP spokespersons have often complained that the social media site is slack when it comes to acting against abusive behaviour of their political rivals, while being quick to suspend right-wing accounts.

Social media companies have been in touch with the Election Commission and

guidelines are being worked out, but the committee is keen to examine how Twitter India is dealing with complaints of bias and fake news. The panel would like to be informed of the technological tools used to detect and filter such comment and how the firm deals with allegations of bias.

Right-wing handles have complained that the number of their followers fluctuates and they are sometimes unable to track their retweets ac-

curately. The interaction will take place on February 11.

There have, however, been similar complaints from other users who feel Twitter is unfair to their points of view. There was a controversy during a the recent visit of Twitter CEO Jack Dorsey to India when he was photographed posing with a placard allegedly bashing the "Brahmin community". The poster was given to him during an interaction with journalists and activists.

## Kerala church issues rules to curb sex abuse

**Kochi:** The Kerala Catholic Bishops Council has issued guidelines to protect minors and adults in church-run institutions from any form of sexual abuse. The guidelines, issued in the wake of several priests and bishops facing sexual assault charges, has proposed "strict action" against offenders.

Though the document titled KCBC Guidelines for Safe Environment Programme was issued last year, it entered public domain recently. On January 11, TOI had reported on Syro Malabar church's decision to implement the norms. These also mooted a mechanism to address false accusations against the clergy, employees associated with the church. TNN

## Ujjwala foot soldiers to fuel govt's outreach before polls

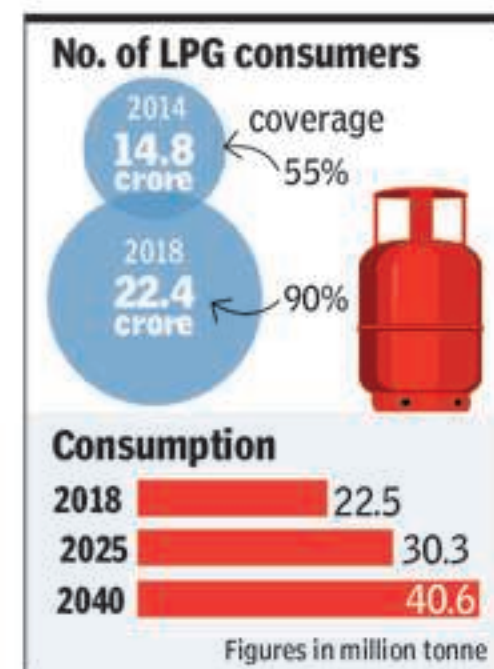

**New Delhi:** With barely a month to go before the election is announced, the oil ministry has mobilised 'Ujjwala foot soldiers' — field executives implementing the free LPG connection scheme — in a move seen as consolidating the government's grassroots outreach.

Sources said some 3,000 employees of state-run fuel retailers managing the government's flagship welfare scheme at the ground level from across the country are scheduled to congregate at Delhi's Talkatora indoor stadium on Thursday for a day-long jamboree.

Officially, the function is being organised to "felicitate" the district nodal officers (DNOs) for their contribution to the success of Ujjwala. But the timing and style of the event underpin efforts at exploiting its potential for political outreach.

For the millions of existing and potential beneficiar-



ies of Ujjwala, DNOs give the central government a face. These executives are responsible for educating folks about Ujjwala's benefit, enrolling potential beneficiaries, strengthening infrastructure and coordinating with local administration as well as elected representatives.

With such grassroots connect, in poll season DNOs can prove to be a formidable grouping for consolidating the goodwill flowing from the

welfare scheme. Perhaps that explains the scale in which the event is being organised, though the DNOs have had their share of appreciation from time to time at scattered functions.

Ujjwala is one of the Narendra Modi government's most formidable achievements, providing free LPG connection to women from over 6 crore poor households since its launch on May 1, 2016. The scheme has changed lives by freeing the womenfolk from smoke from traditional fuels.

On Tuesday, oil minister Dharmendra Pradhan told the Asia LPG Summit here the scheme has succeeded in giving access to clean cooking fuel to all vulnerable sections of society. The scheme has pushed demand, making India the second-largest domestic LPG consumer after China for the third year in a row.

As TOI had first reported on February 6, 2017, India attained this distinction in 2017 barely 10 months after Ujjwala was launched.

## 'Can't ban entry of Kanakadurga to hubby home'

**Malappuram:** The Pulamathol gram nyayalaya here on Tuesday issued a residence order under the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005, allowing Kanakadurga, who recently entered Sabarimala temple, to enter her husband's house in Angadipuram in the district.

Kanakadurga approached the court after she was denied entry to the house when she returned from Sabarimala on January 15. The court order bans

her husband and mother-in-law from refusing her entry to the house. It was on January 2 that Kanakadurga, 39, along with Bindu Ammini entered the Sabarimala temple. When she returned to her husband's house, her mother-in-law Sumathi refused to let her in, which led to a clash between the two and Perinthalmanna police had registered cases against the duo.

The court observed the petitioner was a victim of domestic violence and had the right to live along with her children and husband. Sree Prakash, advocate of Kanakadurga's husband, said they would file an appeal petition in district court. TNN
