#### Initial probe blames auditor, 2 civic engineers

Mumbai: A day after six people were killed when a foot overbridge collapsed outside Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Terminus, a BMC report blamed it on the structural auditor, two civic engineers and a contractor who carried out repairs in 2013.

Departmental inquiries have been ordered against another executive engineer and two retired officers from the bridges department, a move that could affect their pension or dues.

The report released on Friday has recommended an FIR against the auditor, Professor D D Desai's Associated Engineering Consultants & Analysts Pvt Ltd, which had said the FOB is in good condition last year, suspension of the two engineers and blacklisting of the contractor.


