Mumbai: The structural auditor, now in the dock for certifying the Himalaya foot overbridge as fit for use less than seven months before it collapsed on Thursday, had checked 38 other busy bridges in the island city. The contract is worth Rs 63.18 lakh.

Prof D D Desai's Associated Engineering Consultants & Analysts said 12, including the collapsed bridge, are in good condition; nine need major repair; 15 need minor repair; and asked for demolition of three.

Incorporated in 2003 with three directors—owner Neeraj Desai, Hemlata Desai and Neeraj's father Dilipkumar Dahyabhai Desai—the firm operates out of a small flat in a middle-class society in Andheri (W) where the Desai family lives.

On Friday, TOI visited the address—on the top floor of a three-storey building without a lift. A woman answered the bell, but refused to discuss the

bridge audit.

When asked about Neeraj Desai, the woman said 'Mr Desai' was at the BMC headquarters since morning and one should approach him for details. She refused to share the company's address that is registered with the government.

All she said was that although they have an office in the name of the company nearby, they prefer to operate from home. The company is registered with a different address.

Desai's company does not seem to be well-known, and af-

ter the incident it raised many eyebrows in civic circles. Several senior corporators questioned the BMC decision to award the bridge auditing contract to the company without examining its experience.

Prof D D Desai's Associated Engineering Consultants & Analysts got the contract to audit the 39 bridges in 2016. Two months later, it first inspected the Himalaya bridge in December, and finally submitted the structural audit report in August 2018, stating it was in good condition.

Mechanic fractures both legs a day before dad's scheduled amputation

For the past four months, it had become a ritual for Mohammed Athar, 28, to visit G T Hospital every night. The resident of Mumbai's Byculla would carry dinner for his 67-year-old father who has been admitted to the hospital since November for treatment of a diabetic foot. On Thursday, too, Athar was headed to the hospital when the Himalaya bridge collapsed.



The father of two suffered multiple fractures in his legs and has lost a finger. "After months of waiting, my father was finally scheduled for an amputation of the right lower limb on Friday," said Athar, lying on a St George Hospital bed. Athar, who worked as a mechanic, said, "Who will feed my family or take care of the medical expenses if I am jobless for three months?"

Aniket Jadhav (19) cannot believe that he got lucky twice. The teenager from Wadala recalled how as soon as he fell along with the collapsing bridge and landed on the road, the rear wheels of an SUV came dangerously close to him as it spun after emergency brakes were applied. Though injured in multiple places, Jadhav recalled, he gathered all his strength to move away from the car.

Doctors said he has suffered an injury to his hips. His mother Bandini said his son had recently begun to contribute to their family's income. "I hope the injuries don't leave him with any long-term health issues," she said, adding a compensation amount of Rs 50,000 was too little since the victims would be out of jobs for long. Pak govt sneakily grabs Kartarpur gurdwara land

India Lodges Protest, Pak Fails To Explain Encroachment

New Delhi: India lodged a strong protest with Pakistan on Thursday over rampant encroachment of land belonging to Gurdwara Kartarpur Sahib in Narowal across the border, including "surreptitious takeover" of some parts by the country's government in the name of developing a corridor.

During talks on opening the Kartarpur corridor, New Delhi demanded that the encroached land be restored to the gurdwara at the earliest, keeping in mind strong sentiments on the issue among Indian devotees. Officials here said India

was shocked to learn Pakistan had allowed such encroachment. "The land was donated to the gurdwara by Maharaja Ranjit Singh Ji and other eminent Sikh devotees over a period of time. Land owned by the gurdwara has also been acquired by the government of Pakistan. India

has protested against the impropriety of arbitrarily depriving the gurdwara of its legal possessions, in utter disregard to sentiments of devotees of Shri Guru Nanak Dev Ji in India. A strong demand has been made by the Indian side for early restoration of the land to the gurdwara," said a senior government official who was part of the meeting in Attari between joint-secretary level home ministry officials, assisted by foreign ministry representatives, and Pakistani foreign ministry officials.

Pakistan, on its part, had little explanation to offer for the encroachment of the land that was originally

spread over 100 acres. Officials said Pakistan fell way short of its leadership's "tall claims and promises" that they were making a great concession for Indian devotees by opening up the corridor.

Significantly, Pakistan insisted on a mere two-year validity for a memorandum of understanding on the corridor even though India has initiated the process of constructing a permanent structure comprising a passenger terminal to facilitate 5,000 pilgrims a day. Incidentally, all that Pakistan committed to was allowing 500 pilgrims a day, which at most could be stretched to 700.

Uncle found murdered, Jagan claims Naidu's hand

Kadapa: Less than a month before the elections in Andhra Pradesh, former minister and YSR Congress leader Y S Vivekananda Reddy was allegedly murdered at his native Pulivendula village in Kadapa district late Thursday night. He was the uncle of YSR Congress chief Y S Jagan Mohan Reddy.

Preliminary investigation by the police revealed that Vivekananda, 69, was murdered late Thursday night. Post mortem examination showed seven injuries on his body caused by a sharp weapon. The death sparked a major political row, with Jagan accusing

Andhra CM N Chandrababu Naidu and his son Lokesh of being behind the killing and the CM denying any role in the incident. Naidu condoned his death and said those involved in the murder will be booked, however big they are.

Vivekananda's body was found lying in a pool of blood in the bathroom. There were injuries on the forehead, back of the head, thighs and wrists. Vivekananda was expected to get the YSRCP ticket for Pulivendula assembly segment and his murder has come as a rude shock to the party. Tragically, Vivekananda's father Y S Raja Reddy was also murdered before the 1999 polls.

Vivekananda was the younger brother of Jagan's father Y S Rajasekhara Reddy. He went to Pulivendula two days ago, the same day when he was spotted at Jagan's residence in Hyderabad. Even on Thursday, he took part in campaigning at Pulivendula. He was alone when the crime took place.

Naidu has formed a special investigation team to probe the case. Late in the evening, he rejected the demand for a CBI probe by YSRCP.

Nun faces ouster for rape protest

Wayanad: A final notice has been issued by church authorities to a nun who took part in a protest against rape accused Franco Mulakal, former Bishop of the Jalandhar diocese, asking her to leave her congregation.

In its final notice, the Franciscan Clarist Congregation accused Sister Lucy Kalapura, belonging to its St Mary's province at Mananthavady, of leading a life which was against the rule of the congregation.

On Friday, Kalapura said that the church authorities have given the notice asking her either to leave the congregation or to face ouster.

"It's sad that the church has asked me to leave the

congregation. I joined the church when I was 17. I have lived a life following all the principles of religious life. My reply to the second warning letter earlier was very clear: I have explained my stand," she said.

The nun has been asked to give her explanation to Superior General Sister at Generalate of the Congregation

before April 16. The congregation termed as "grave violations", a nun taking a licence, buying a car, taking a loan for it and publishing a book. The congregation termed as a "grave scandal" the nun participating in TV news channels' discussions, "levelling false charges against the Catholic leadership and belittling it."

Rebel camps razed on Myanmar front

New Delhi: Around a dozen insurgent bases and camps have been "smashed" along the India-Myanmar border, with the countries' armies working in close coordination to eliminate threats in the region, especially to the ongoing Kaladan multi-modal transit project to boost connectivity in the northeast.

Even as the Myanmar army has stepped up operations against insurgent groups operating in its territory since January, Indian forces have reinforced their positions with an additional 15 infantry and Assam Rifles battalions, Special Forces and drones along the entire 1,643-km-long land border in a major operation codenamed 'Operation Sunrise' to prevent any "spillover", security establishment so-

urces said on Friday.

"Myanmar army, in its latest operation conducted from February 17 onwards in its Chin state opposite South Mizoram, has destroyed 10-12 camps of the Arakan Army, an insurgent group based in Myanmar closely associated with the Kachin Independence Army which has links with China," said a source. The operation was conducted because it was assessed Arakan Army insurgents were posing a threat to the Kaladan project.
