

# CBI books Hyderabad firm for cheating SBI

**THE CBI HAS** booked promoters of a Hyderabad-based construction and leasing company for alleged criminal conspiracy and cheating in availing of loans which turned into NPA, causing a loss of ₹8.20 crore to State Bank of India, officials said on Monday.

They said the agency has filed an FIR against the company, BNR Infra and Leasing, its promoters B Narasimha Reddy, S Bindusagar Reddy, advocates Nellutla Jagan, V Narasinga Rao and D Prabhakara Reddy and valuers N Datatreyyudu and L Kishore Chand.

They have been booked under IPC sections related to criminal conspiracy, cheating and forgery, among others.

The FIR has been registered on the basis of a complaint

nership firm with Bindusagar Reddy being added as a partner.

In 2015, loans taken by the company were declared as non-performing assets (NPAs) with ₹8.20 crore outstanding.

During the loan recovery proceedings under the SARFAESI Act, the bank realised that collateral security document borrowed for the purpose by the borrower was not enforceable and bank could not recover its amount.

It is alleged that the promoters supplied forged documents to show that land was non-agriculture.

The valuation report was also forged assessing the value of property at ₹4.66 crore. Bank valuers also allegedly submitted fraudulent reports to say that property submitted as collateral was a non-agriculture one.

# NGT asks poll panel, govt to consider banning plastic campaign material

**THE NATIONAL GREEN** Tribunal has directed the Election Commission, the Centre and the Central Pollution Control Board to convene a meeting to consider whether to ban the use of campaigning material made of plastic during elections.

A Bench headed by NGT chairperson Justice Adarsh Kumar Goel directed the Election Commission, Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEF&CC) and CPCB to convene a meeting at the earliest, preferably within one week.

# Social media misuse: IT min submits responses to House panel's queries

**THE IT MINISTRY HAS** submitted responses to queries posed by a parliamentary panel on various issues, including liability of social media platforms in instances of fake news circulation and efficacy of the IT Act in curbing the misuse of such platforms, said a source.

Among the 40 questions that the information technology (IT) ministry has responded to included amendments proposed in the IT Act and its rules to deal specifically with issues related to social media platforms and intermediaries, and purported delay in bringing about the said changes.

A government official privy to the developments said the list of questions dealing primarily with the issue of safeguarding citizens' rights on social or online news media platforms was sent last month by the Parliamentary Standing Committee on IT, which had recently summoned senior representatives of Twitter, and now Facebook and WhatsApp.

The mechanisms posed ranged from questions with the government to monitor compliance of guidelines by social media platforms to

actions taken on instances of misuse.

One of the questions pertained to how an IT intermediary is differing from a 'media house' exerting editorial control, and another one on the regulatory scenario in other countries such as the US, China, the UK and the European Union.

It also asked whether the ministry has any mechanism in place to curb misuse of social media platforms, particularly in the view of the upcoming general elections,

and safeguards that are being taken to keep the election process safe.

Other issues pertain to "major challenges" faced by the ministry in the social media domain.

The committee also sought the ministry's response to whether it has felt any need to have a regulator for social media platforms, in view of the potential of such platforms to influence public perception. It also sought information on actions taken by the ministry to curb the spread of fake news, and to tackle the menace of abusive tweets and trolling. It also inquired about the privacy norms for social media platforms operating in India, and the grievance redressal mechanism available to users of social media platform in the country.

use of short-life PVC (polyvinyl chloride), synthetic plastic polymer and chlorinated plastic which includes banners, hoarding, etc for promotion and advertising during the poll campaign.

The petition, moved by V Edwin Wilson through advocate Sanjay Upadhyay, claimed that campaigning material made of plastic are used during election and later discarded as waste, which was detrimental to the environment.

The petition also claimed that a letter was sent to the secretary, MoEF&CC, seeking directions to all state governments and the Election Commission for imposing complete prohibition of PVC hoarding/banners/flexes by implementing and complying with the environmental norms, but no response was received.
