For first time, Indian Coffee House set to hire women

Kannur: The Indian Coffee House, established as a cooperative by communist leader A K Gopalan in 1958 after coffee outlets under the Coffee Board dismissed its workers, had never employed women at its outlets. Now, after almost 61 years, the cooperative chain of hotels, which also runs outlets across the country, including the one in Kolkata's College Street, has written a new chapter in its history by allowing six women to join the establishment as staffers at three outlets in Kannur and Kozhikode.

"When the world is changing and women are breaking into top roles in all professions, it is high time the Coffee House opened its doors to them," said P V Balakrishnan, president of the Indian Coffee Workers' Cooperative Society, Kannur, which took the initiative to appoint women at its coffeehouses for the first time in the country.

"Our society functions in the entire Malabar region, including Palakkad, and I feel happy that we have set a model for the entire establishment," he said on Wednesday. If the move proves successful, the society has plans to appoint more women. In fact, they have already prepared a rank list.

Balakrishnan said though the society has been considering appointing women staff, it was industries minister E P Jayarajan's suggestion that spurred them to action. The first batch of six women was appointed on March 5 and two each have been posted at Kannur and Kozhikode outlets.

"Initially, they have been appointed as kitchen assistants and have been put on day duty. We will deploy them in service after they acquire the required skills," Balakrishnan said. In future, it may even consider opening all-women outlets, he said, adding that food prepared by women may drive demand.

Bhopal: Unleashing a potential game changer for Congress in MP ahead of Lok Sabha elections, CM Kamal Nath announced on Wednesday a 27% quota for OBCs (up by 13%) and implementation of the 10% reservation for economically backward sections in the general category. This takes the total quotas in the state to above 70%.

He also announced a mega recruitment drive to fill 60,000 government posts even as his government hiked DA for state employees to 9%

for state employees to 9%. "Today I have announced 27% reservation for OBCs and 10% for general class. This is a big issue. BJP leaders who always boast about their 'interest' for OBCs could not increase the quota for backward sections during the 15 years of their regime. But we have decided to

increase the quota to 27%" the CM said in Sagar on Wednesday. BJP dubbed the announcement a "delayed decision" that is unlikely to benefit the youth before elections. The Congress government also hiked DA for state government employees from 7% to 9% effective from July 1, 2018.

HC nixes Maha relief for 11 fake encounter cops

Mumbai: The Bombay high court on Wednesday struck down Maharashtra government's decision to suspend the life sentence of 11 police officers convicted in the 2006 fake encounter of Ramnarayan Gupta alias Lakhman Bhैया, an alleged close aide of gangster Chhota Rajan. A division bench of Justice Bhushan Dharmadhikari and Justice Revati Dere termed the state's decision "perverse". The bench also castigated special CBI judge for the "casual and cavalier" way recommendation was given to suspend the punishment. The high court had subsequently, in an interim order, stayed the decision and sent the 11 cops back to jail. Gupta and his friend Anil Bhecha were picked up by a police team from Vashi on November 11, 2006. Gupta was killed in a fake encounter near Versova the same day. In 2013, a sessions court acquitted prime accused encounter specialist Pradeep Sharma, but convicted 21 others, including Pradeep Suryawanshi and 12 other police officers. Full report on www.toi.in

Find out if TV serials lead to extramarital affairs: HC

Chennai: The Madras high court has asked the central and state governments to find out if exposure to "mega television serials", among other things, was responsible for extramarital relationships which it said were responsible for a spurt in crimes such as murder, assault and kidnapping. The court wanted to know whether the economic independence of both spouses, the internet, sexual dysfunction, social media, westernisation, and lack of quality family time were the primary reasons for an increase in extramarital relationships. The court also asked the authorities to explain whether arranged marri-

ages conducted against the wishes of the bride or the groom and mismatch of couples were also reasons for such relationships. The court suggested that a committee of retired judges and experts be set up to analyse the social menace and that family counselling centres be set up in every district. A division bench of Justices N Kirubakaran and Ab-

dul Quddhose said, "Extramarital relationship has become a dangerous social evil. Many heinous crimes, including murders, assaults, kidnappings, are committed because of clandestine relationships and they are increasing day by day. Moreover, murders are being committed by a husband or wife to continue the relationship with the paramour." In an effort to find out the reasons and ways to prevent the offences, certain queries were being raised by this court. The bench then asked "mega television serials" and movies were major reasons for the increase in extramarital relationships, and whether such serials and films invariably gave inspiration to commit such offences.

Examinee kills herself fearing strip-search

Raipur: Terrified of being strip-searched, a Class 10 examinee hanged herself in a village in Chhattisgarh's Jashpur on Monday. "I will die if this were to happen to me," the 16-year-old had told her brother on March 1, while narrating how two girls and a boy from her school were forced to undress and were searched for 'chits' minutes before they entered the exam hall. She was found dead on March 4. Jashpur collector Nilesh Kshirsagar has ordered an enquiry but no case had been registered till Wednesday. Statements of the principal and students needed to be recorded, but the administration doesn't want to disturb children during board exams, said an official.

Govt puts complete ban on import of solid plastic waste

New Delhi: Taking an important step towards tackling the menace of plastic waste in India, the government has completely banned import of solid plastic waste/scrap into the country. India generates 25,940 tonnes of plastic waste every day. Earlier, such import was partly banned as India did not prohibit it in special economic zones (SEZ). Besides, import of plastic waste/scrap was also allowed by export oriented units (EOUs) which used to procure it from abroad as post-recycling resources.

"The country has now completely prohibited the import of solid plastic waste by amending the Hazardous Waste (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules on March 1," an environment ministry official said. He said the rules were amended keeping in view the huge gap between waste generation and recycling capacity in the country and also India's commitment to phase out single-use plastic by 2022. After being banned by China a few years ago, India had emerged as one of the world's largest plastic waste importers. Since there is no adequate capacity of recycling of plas-

tic waste in the country, a huge quantity of such hazardous waste remains uncollected, causing substantial damage to soil and water bodies. According to a study conducted by the Central Pollution Control Board, 10,376 tonnes (40%) out of the 25,940 tonnes of plastic waste per day remains uncollected in the country. The ministry also made a provision where white category (practically non-polluting or very less polluting) of industries will have to hand over hazardous wastes generated in their units to authorised users, waste collectors or disposal facilities.
