HOURS BEFORE President Ram Nath Kovind appointed him Prime Minister for a second term, Narendra Modi Saturday urged NDA MPs to punch holes in the illusion of fear among minorities in the country saying the new government also stands for those whose trust the ruling coalition is yet to win.

In his first speech after being elected leader of the BJP-led NDA, Modi asked 353 newly elected MPs to work without any discrimination on the basis of faith and caste. "The way the poor have been cheated, the minorities have been deceived the same way. It would have been good if their education, their health had been in focus. I expect from you in 2019 that you will be able to puncture that deception. We have to earn their trust," he said.

"We stand for those who trusted us and for those whose trust we have to win over... There is no other. Everybody is ours... I will try to win hearts." The Prime Minister also made an addition

A tale of two Modi speeches: Regional aspirations, sabka vishwas new in 2019

PRIME MINISTER Narendra Modi's speech in Central Hall of Parliament Saturday appeared to build upon his maiden speech in the same hall when he was elected for his first term five years ago.

"My government will be

dedicated to the poor," Modi had said in his maiden address to the BJP Parliamentary Party in Central Hall on May 20, 2014, before he was formally appointed Prime Minister by then President Pranab Mukherjee.

On Saturday, he said: "Between 2014 and 2019 we ran a government for the poor. Now

the poor have made this government."

He expanded his 2014 call of "Sabka Saath, Sabka Vikas" to "Sabka Saath, Sabka Vikas aur Sabka Vishwas" as the mantra for taking India to newer heights. The goal of winning the confidence of all

Five students killed in Surat fire clear

Class 12: 'What do we do with results now?'

MANSI VARSANI always wanted to be a fashion designer and when the Gujarat board Class 12 results were announced Saturday, she got a C1 grade. Her family was meant to celebrate this moment but instead, an hour before the results were announced, her parents were at her funeral.

Mansi was among the 22 students killed in the fire that engulfed the Takshashila arcade in Surat Friday. And like most of the other students who died, she was attending summer coaching classes on the building's roof, where the fire started. There were 35 students in the class at

the time.

Mansi's body had not been identified Friday, but a day later, her parents spotted the jaw of one of the bodies — there were two teeth missing and they

Former Jet chairman, wife stopped from going abroad

IMMIGRATION OFFICIALS at the Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj International Airport on Saturday stopped former Jet Airways chairman Naresh Goyal and his wife Anita from travelling abroad. Sources said the couple was heading to Dubai on Emirates flight EK 507.

The flight was taxiing for takeoff when it was called back, sources said.

"The immigration department informed the ATCOfficials, who then asked the pilot to re-

turn. Officials boarded the plane and spoke to Goyal. He and his wife were offloaded along with their checked-in baggage," said an officer, requesting anonymity.

Sources said Goyal and his wife Anita were restricted from leaving the country. "After they deboarded, they were taken away by immigration officers."

3 thrashed for carrying 'beef' in MP, arrested

TWO MEN were beaten up with sticks — one was tied to a tree — and made to raise slogans of "Jai Shri Ram" by five suspected *gau rakshaks*, who accused them of carrying beef, in Seoni district of Madhya Pradesh, police said. A video clip of the incident, which is being circulated on social media, also shows the accused forcing one of the men to beat up a woman accompanying them and making her chant "Jai Shri Ram".

The incident occurred in Dunda Seoni area on May 22. Police said the three persons who were beaten up — identified as Taufik, Anjum Shama and Dilip Malviya — were arrested the same day after the suspected *gau rakshaks* claimed that they

Dabholkar case: Sanstha lawyer among two held

THE CBI on Saturday arrested an advocate and his aide, both of whom have links with the radical outfit Sanatan Sanstha, in connection with the murder of anti-superstition activist Dr Narendra Dabholkar in Pune in August 2013.

The advocate, Sanjiv Punalekar, is an officebearer of the lawyers' body Hindu Vidhidnya Parishad, and has been representing some of the accused arrested earlier in the Dabholkar murder case. He often appears on TV and is quoted in the news media speaking for the accused. He also provides legal support to Sanatan Sanstha activists and other Hindutva
