RBI revises stressed asset resolution norms

Introduces 'review period' of 30 days to recognise default

SPECIAL CORRESPONDENT

After the Supreme Court struck down the controversial February 12, 2018 circular of Reserve Bank of India (RBI) on stressed asset resolution, the banking regulator on Friday released revised set of norms which are substantially less stringent from

In particular, neither there is a mandate to start resolution which results in higher provisioning if there is a single day default nor a mandate for initiating insolvency proceeding if resolution plan is not implemented for large accounts within a time frame. However, the RBI has sought to nudge banks towards the insolvencv courts by introducing a disincentive in the form of additional provisions for delayed resolution.

At the same time, the central bank said it would issue directions to banks for initiation of insolvency proceedings against borrowers for specific defaults 'so that the momentum towards effective resolution remains uncompromised.

The new circular asked lenders to undertake a prima facie review of the borrower account within 30 days from a default, which is termed as "review period."

During this review period, lenders may decide on the resolution strategy, including the nature of the resolution plan (RP), the approach for implementation of the

All lenders to enter into inter-creditor pact for implementing resolution plan





If the RP is to be implemented, lenders have been asked to enter into an intercreditor agreement (ICA), within the review period, to provide for ground rules for finalisation and implementation of the RP.

"The ICA shall provide that any decision agreed by lenders representing 75% by value of total outstanding credit facilities (fund-based as well as non-fund based) and 60% of lenders by number shall be binding upon all the lenders," the circular said. The RP will have to implemented within 180 days from the end of review period, RBI said.

The review period shall commence not later than the date of the this circular for loans above ₹2000 crore; January 1 ,2020 for loans above ₹1,500 crore to ₹2,000 crore.

For loans less than ₹1,500 crore, the reference date would be announced later.

There is a disincentive for banks if they delay implementing a viable resolution plan. In case the plan is not implemented within 180 days from the end of review period, banks have to make additional provision of 20% and another 15% if the plan is not implemented within 365 days from the start of the review period.

The additional provisions would be reversed if resolution is pursued under Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code

Half of the additional provisions could be reversed on filing of insolvency application and the remaining additional provisions may be reversed once case is admitted for insolvency proceedings.

"Incentives to reverse 50% of these provisions upon reference under IBC will incentivise lenders to refer such stressed cases to IBC for faster resolution," says Karthik Srinivasan, group head, financial sector ratings ICRA, who thinks the overall framework is positive and will continue to incentivise banks for accelerated resolution of stressed assets.

Debt recast tools like corporate debt restructuring scheme and strategic debt restructuring scheme are withdrawn. Apart from banks, these new norms are also applicable for non-banking financial companies, small finance banks and other financial institutions.

SEBI, MCA sign pact for more data scrutiny

MoU to enable seamless sharing of data to carry out investigation, prosecution

The Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) and the Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU) to facilitate seamless sharing of data and information for carrying out scrutiny, inspection, investigation and prosecution.

This assumes significance as the MCA has the database of all registered firms while SEBI only regulates listed entities that may have unlisted subsidiaries, with the MCA having access to all the data of such unlisted entities.

The MoU will ensure that both the MCA and the SEBI have seamless linkage for regulatory purposes and in addition to regular exchange of data, the two will also exchange with each other, on request, any available information for scrutiny, inspection, investigation and prosecution.

RBI raps Kotak bank for veil over promoter data

Fines private sector lender ₹2 crore

Amid a legal battle between Kotak Mahindra Bank and the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) over the former's promoter stake dilution, the central bank has now slapped a penalty of ₹2 crore on the private sector lender for not disclosing information on promoter shareholding.

"The bank was directed by the RBI to furnish information about details of the shareholding held by its promoters and to submit details of the proposed course of action/plans/strategy of the bank for complying with the permitted timeline for dilution of promoter shareholding," the banking regulator said.

"Subsequently, the bank was directed to convey its commitment to achieve the dilution as per the timelines stipulated. However, the bank failed to comply with the said directions and a notice was issued to the bank advising it to show cause as to why penalty should not be imposed for non-compliance with the said directions," it added.

Last year, the lender moved the Bombay High Court after RBI rejected its bid to reduce promoter shareholding by issuing preference shares. The bank was supposed to lower promoter stake to 20%, from about 30%, by Dec 31, 2018 and to 15% by March 31, 2020. The court is yet to pronounce its judgment on the issue.

DHFL repays over ₹350 crore to investors

Includes ₹100 cr. repayment for CPs

Mortgage lender Dewan Housing Finance Corporation Ltd. has paid over ₹350 crore to different investors, including ₹100 crore to investors of commercial paper (CP). The CP was due for repayment on Friday.

DHFL sources said some interest payments have also been made to investors of non-convertible debentures (NCDs), which were due earlier this week, but were de-

The company still had seven working days to make the payment to avoid default. DHFL, which is facing cash crunch after bank loans became expensive, is selling loans to other lenders to generate resources.

"UTI MF anticipates that there would be enhanced pressure and legal action on DHFL from all creditors, including exercise of early redemption clause and legal options by various lenders. This is expected to further delay the recovery efforts of the company in disposal of its assets in an orderly manner," UTI MF said in a

The fund house said it has "increased the markdown to DHFL debt securities from 75% to 100% in the schemes which has an exposure to DHFL."

time when the Ministry of Civil Aviation has constituted a committee to re-allocate Jet Airways' foreign traffic rights to various airlines. The position of the government so far is that these were 'earmarked' for domestic carriers.

The shutdown of Jet Airways, which had the largest market share among all Indian airlines on foreign routes and second largest

domestically, has led to a sharp rise in airfares.

With Jet out of skies, sector may fly into profit

CAPA flips estimate from loss-making scenario to \$500-\$700 mn profit for FY20

The exit of Jet Airways from the civil aviation scene has changed the outlook of the airline sector from negative to positive, according to an aviation consulting firm.

In its latest forecast, the Centre for Asia Pacific Aviation (CAPA) revised its FY20 profitability outlook from a consolidated loss of \$550-\$700 million to a profit of \$500-\$700 million for the sector.

"India's leading airlines are expected to report record profits, while Air India could break even at a net level. Low cost carriers are likely to report a combined profit of \$500-\$700 million, of which IndiGo alone could account for \$400-\$500 million," CAPA said in its Q1

International traffic is likely to be flat at best, and could show a slight decline of up to 5%. Growth is expected to resume from FY21. "Jet's closure leaves a notable gap in

the international market. As a result Indian carriers will increase their focus overseas. Indian LCCs are expected to deploy 40 additional narrow bodies (planes) on regional international routes in FY2020," it said. Prior to operations being impacted, Jet Airways ac-

Paint sector sees demand boost

Softer raw materials prices may help raise margins, says Indian Paint Association

SPECIAL CORRESPONDENT KOLKATA

The two Cabinet committees set up by the new government at the Centre to give impetus to employment and growth are expected to boost the Indian paint industry, said Abhijit Roy, the outgoing chairman of the Indian Paint Association.

"The outlook is good and margins too may improve this year on account of softer raw material prices," Mr. Roy said at a press meet.

"While employment growth will boost demand, economic growth has a direct impact on the paint industry," he added.

Value, volume growth During 2018-19, the paint industry grew 15% by value and 12% by volume. However, margins came under

pressure due to high oil prices and the rupee volatility.

Mr. Roy said that while there was scope for optimism in the decorative and protective paints segment, there was some concern about the automotive paint sector in the first half of the financial year. "We are hoping [for] second half recovery for the automobile [paint] industry," he said.

The organised sector paint industry accounts for 70% of the ₹50,000-crore industry, while the rest is accounted for by the unorganised segment. Earlier at a public session, Dipankar Chakrabarti, executive director - technology optimisation lead, PwC, said that the industry needed to understand the importance of adopting a digital strategy beyond hosting a website and an app.

'62% rise in profitability' "If you are innovative with your process, production and manpower, then it is possible to enhance your profitability by around 62%," Mr. Chakrabarti said.

Commander Manoj Kr Gupta (retired) of Garden Reach Shipbuilders Ltd. said that there was a sustained demand for paints for warships as the Navy was expanding its fleet.

Propose to source more desalinated water, says Sterlite

South Ganga Water Tech supplies water to T.N. plant

Vedanta Ltd. has proposed to step up the quantum of desalinated water sourced from South Ganga Water Technologies (P) Limited (SGWT) for its Sterlite Copper unit at Thoothukudi.

Thoothukudi has a lone desalination plant, which is operated by SGWT. The unit started with an installed capacity of 3 million litres per day (MLD) in 2013-14 and expanded to 7 MLD.

The unit has been supplying desalinated water to Sterlite Copper since 2013-14. "We aim to significantly increase the quantum of desalinated water sourced from



SGWT," said an official of the company. The Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board (TWAD) is responsible for drawing water from local river sources and allocating it for various applications such as domestic consumption, agriculture, utilities and industries in Thoothukudi region. The entire wa-

ter supply infrastructure is installed and operated by the TWAD board.

Also, Sterlite has a contract with SIPCOT for water supply for industrial consumption. The firm supplies water to all industries within the SIPCOT complex in Thoothukudi. SIPCOT has a water purchase pact with TWAD which enables the former to ensure supply to firms in the area for industrial use. "Although the sanctioned quantity by SIPCOT to Sterlite Copper was 3.5 million gallons per day (MGD), its actual consumption never exceeded 2.5 MGD," the Sterlite official claimed.
