Aligarh child's murder: Wife, brother of key accused held

THE UTTAR Pradesh police Saturday arrested the wife and the brother of Jahed, an accused in the murder of a two-year-old girl in Aligarh, for their alleged involvement in the crime.

The arrests come days after Jahed and another accused were held after the decomposed body of the girl was found in a garbage dump near Jahed's home.

"Jahed's wife and his brother Mehdi Hasan were arrested on Saturday and have been sent to iail. Their role had come up during the investigation. We have also recovered the piece of clothing in which the girl's body was wrapped. It belongs to Jahed's wife, who has admitted to it. Prima facie, it appears that they will be probed under IPC Section 120B (conspiracy)," said a senior

police officer. Jahed and another accused allegedly abducted the girl from outside her home on May 30, and disposed her body in a garbage dump after killing her – allegedly over a monetary dispute Jahed had with the girl's CONTINUED ON PAGE 2

Easter attacks: NIA shares with Sri Lanka numbers of five locals linked to IS

IN THE wake of the Easter Sunday bombings which killed more than 250 people, India has shared with Sri Lanka phone numbers of five Lankans suspected to be associated with Islamic State (IS). India has also shared call logs and details of some Indians who were in touch with the family of two Lankan suicide bombers involved in the attacks.

A National Investigation Agency (NIA) team was in Sri Lanka last week in connection with the agency's probe into two IS modules in India that are suspected to have had connections in Sri Lanka. "The NIA had found

four to five numbers in Sri Lanka which were in touch either directly or through social media with certain Islamic State suspects in India. These have been shared with Lankan authorities further investigation. **CONTINUED ON PAGE 2**

Terror the biggest threat, need a global summit of leaders to combat it: PM

TO PLUG loopholes in the fight against terror. Prime Minister Narendra Modi Saturday proposed a "global conference" on countering terrorism, along the lines of summits on climate change.

Addressing the Maldivian Parliament on his first bilateral visit in the second term, Modi said that "the water is now rising above the head", as he urged world leaders to unite to combat the menace.

Describing the fight against terror and radicalisation as world's biggest challenge, the Prime Minister said, "The way the global community has **CONTINUED ON PAGE 2**

3 workers killed in clash with TMC: BJP

THE BJP on Saturday claimed two of its local leaders and a party worker had been killed and at least five workers seriously wounded in a violent clash with Trinamool Congress workers in Sandeshkhali in North 24-Parganas district, about 75 km southeast of Kolkata.

The Trinamool made a counter allegation that BJP workers had attacked and killed one of their workers.


