1) **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:**

- 1. All regular employees possessing prescribed educational qualification as indicated above, working in 7th CPC Level lower than the Grade Pay/Scale for which GDCE is being conducted are eligible to appear in GDCE selection,
- 2. All regular employees possessing prescribed educational qualification as indicated above working in same 7th CPC Level for which GDCE is being conducted are eligible to appear in selection from non-safety to safety category posts as well as safety to safety category posts.
- 3. Those candidates who are appearing in and/or awaiting for results of final examination of minimum qualification at the time of applying for the post are not eligible. Academic qualification must be from recognized Educational Institution / Board, otherwise candidature will be rejected.
- 4. The candidates should possess the requisite educational qualification on the closing date of application and the same should also be endorsed in the Service Sheet of the employees.
- 5. Zone of consideration for GDCE will encompass staff belonging to all the Departments/Branches in a Divisions/Workshops/Headquarters office/Extra-Divisional Offices, as the case may be, subject to their applying in response to the notification.

- 6. RPF/RPSF personnel are not eligible to apply against the GDCE scheme in terms of Railway Board'sletter No. E (NG) I/2002/PM2/9 dated 11.8.2003.
- 7. Employees selected under GDCE scheme shall be subjected to initial training of the same duration prescribed for directly recruited candidates through RRBs.
- 8. **Age Criteria**: The upper age limit will be 42 years for General candidates, 45 years for OBC candidates and 47 years for SC/ST candidates.

Age will be reckoned as on 1/7/2019.

- 9. <u>PROOF OF AGE:-</u> Birth Certificate issued by appropriate authority or Matric/SSC/SSLC certificate or mark sheet indicating Date of Birth issued by Board or School leaving/Transfer certificate issued by Schools/College Authority.
- 10. The candidates fulfilling eligibility criteria for various post of both NTPC(UG) categories and NTPC(G) Categories can apply for both the categories. However, separate applications should be submitted for NTPC (Under-Graduate) categories and NTPC (Graduate) categories.
- 11. Separate single stage written examinations -Computed Based Test(CBT)/ OMR based examinations will be conducted for NTPC (Graduate) categories and NTPC (Under-Graduate) categories. The choice of post should be given at the time of application.
- 12. The date, time and venue of the examination will be fixed by RRC/ Mumbai and will be intimated to the eligible candidates through website as well as through SMS on registered Mobile number/or through email on registered mail address. The candidates should regularly visit the website.
- 13. The request for postponement of examination or change of venue will not be entertained under any circumstances.
- 14. The standard of the examination shall be of the level of RRB examination of Notified post. The Question paper shall be of Objective Multiple Choice Type. The question paper will be in English/Hindi/Urdu/Marathi/Gujarati. The Questions will be of objective type with multiple choices and are likely to include questions pertaining to:
- **a. Mathematics:** Number System, Decimals, Fractions, LCM, HCF, Ratio and Proportions, Percentage, Mensuration, Time and Work, Time and Distance, Simple and Compound Interest, Profit and Loss, Elementary Algebra, Geometry and Trigonometry, Elementary Statistics etc.

b. General Intelligence and Reasoning:

Analogies, Completion of Number and Alphabetical Series, Coding and Decoding, Mathematical Operations, Similarities and Differences, Relationships, Analytical Reasoning, Syllogism,

Jumbling, Venn Diagrams, Puzzle, Data Sufficiency, Statement- Conclusion, Statement- Courses of Action, Decision Making, Maps, Interpretation of Graphs etc.

c. General Awareness:

Current Events of National and International Importance, Games and Sports, Art and Culture of India, Indian Literature, Monuments and Places of India, General Science and Life Science (up to 10th CBSE), History of India and Freedom Struggle, Physical, Social and Economic Geography of India and World, Indian Polity and Governance- constitution and political system, General Scientific and Technological Developments including Space and Nuclear Program of India, UN and Other important World Organizations, Environmental Issues Concerning India and World at Large, Basics of Computers and Computer Applications, Common Abbreviations, Transport Systems in India, Indian Economy, Famous Personalities of India and World, Flagship Government Programs, Flora and Fauna of India, Important Government and Public Sector Organizations of India etc.

- 15. Minimum percentage of marks for eligibility in various categories: UR-40%, OBC (Non creamy layer) -30%, SC-30%, ST-25%.
- 16. Railway Administration reserves the right to alter the modus of Examinations or re-conduct examination or to cancel part or whole any process of recruitment at any stage.
- 17. There shall be negative marking in the examination and 1/3 of the allotted marks for each question shall be deducted for every wrong answer.
- 18. For the post of Station Master, Aptitude Test will be conducted for the candidates shortlisted as per the merit in the written examination. For Aptitude Test details, they are advised to visit website of RDSO (www.rdso.indianrailways.gov.in->Directorates -> Psycho Technical Directorate -> Candidates Corner for question patterns & other details.
- 19. The selection shall be made strictly as per merit in the written examination and passing Skill Test wherever prescribed and found fit in prescribed Medical category. Category wise merit list will be formed for all the categories.
- 20. The candidates recommended for appointment should be fit in prescribed Medical category.
- 21. Shortlisted candidates will be called for verification of their original documents. During document verification the candidates has to bring all necessary documents in original. After satisfactory document verification the candidate will be considered for empanelment subject to fulfillment of other criteria.
- 22. The number of vacancies indicated in the GDCE notification is provisional and may reduce or even become NIL depending upon the actual needs of the Railway Administration. The administration also reserves the right to cancel the notified vacancies at its discretion and such decision will be final and binding on all.
- 23. Selected candidates are liable to be posted anywhere on Western Railway. Decision of Railway Administration in this regard shall be final.

4) Documents to be uploaded:

- 2 Certificates of Educational Qualification for the post applied.
- 3 In the case of SC/ST community candidates, Community certificate issued by the Competent Authority in the prescribe format as per Annexure- I of this Notification.
- 4 In the case of OBC community candidates, Community certificate issued by the Competent Authority in the prescribe format as per Annexure-II of this Notification. This Certificate should specifically indicate that the candidate does not belong to the persons/section (Creamy Layer).
- 5 Candidates claiming to belong to Other Backward Classes are also required to submit a self declaration in the prescribed format. (Annexure III of this Notification).

NOTE: Candidates applying against reserved vacancies (SC/ST/OBC) and/or seeking age relaxation must upload requisite Caste Certificate in the prescribed format issued by the competent authority. Otherwise, their claim for reservation status (SC/ST/OBC) will not be entertained and the candidature/application of such candidates, if fulfilling all the eligibility conditions for General (Un-reserved) category, will be considered under General (UR) vacancy only.

5) INVALID APPLICATIONS:-

- 1. Not having proper scanned Photo and scanned Signature.
- 2. Not having proof of Educational Qualification for the post applied.
- 3. Not having proof of Birth as per Para-9.
- 4. Under aged/Over-aged candidates.
- 5. Not having the requisite Education Qualification at the time of closing date of application.

- 6. Application without uploading the requisite certificates.
- 7. Any other irregularity.

6) ACTION AGAINST CANDIDATES FOUND GUILTY OF MISCONDUCT:-

- 1 Candidates are warned that they should not furnish any particulars that are false or suppress any material information while filling in the application form.
- 2 Candidates are also warned that they should in no case attempt to alter or otherwise tamper with any entry in a document or its attested/certified copy submitted by them nor should they submit a tampered/fabricated document. If there is any inaccuracy or any discrepancy, an explanation regarding such discrepancy should be submitted.
- Misconduct on the part of the candidate at any stage of the recruitment process is strictly prohibited.
