J&K children to get psychological first aid

Hospital opens child-friendly centres as the long lockdown can inflict psycho-social trauma

The lockdown and communication blockade in Jammu and Kashmir can potentially inflict short- or long-term psycho-social trauma in children, say doctors at the Institute of Mental Health and Neuro Sciences (IMHANS) of the Government Medical College here.

"Adults may adapt to the clampdown through culturally transmitted coping mechanisms such as indulging in shop-front debates. However, it's taking a toll on the mental health of children with their eight-hour routine completely disturbed. They have no access to schools, any means of entertainment or the Internet, making them vulnerable to psycho-social abnormalities," says Zaid Ahmad, a senior psychiatrist at

The IMHANS has come up with a contingency plan and in the first phase, will reach out to children (up to the age of 16) in distress in the districts of Kulgam, Shopian, Anantnag and Pulwama. The UNICEF-backed Child Guidance and Wellbeing Centre

at the IMHANS has identified child-friendly centres in schools, homes and anganwadi centres in these districts "to provide psychological first aid".

"The animators and volunteers at the 36 centres will be cal first aid to deal with children facing mental health issues," Syed Karrar Hussian, a child psychiatrist with the UNICEF, told *The Hindu*.

The need for a contingency plan was felt after the number of the children visiting IMHANS fell by one-fifth

after the August 5 decision. "Those who visited us

complained of flared-up symptoms because of the fearful environs and dysfunctional social spaces. There is no peer group interaction, allowing children to share their stories, that act as a protective mechanism. Parents are finding it hard to deal with such children," Dr. Hussain

Permanent scars

He said that in case of prolonged absence of normalcy, reserves of coping mechanisms may vanish. "Once a child exhausts all coping measures, he starts internalising the situation, resulting in self-perpetuating transmission of memory. The trauma inflicted may keep manifesting itself later in the life, and child delinquency is likely to

More U.S. lawmakers raise concerns over Kashmir

There will be consequences for the whole world, Imran writes

Weeks after India ended the special status for Jammu & Kashmir and decided to reorganise the State into two Union Territories, attention on the issue persists in Washington, with many members of the U.S. Congress entering the fray.

"I am excited to see so many members joining us in calling attention to what is happening in Kashmir. Please continue to call your members and ask them to speak up. We expect openness from India," Representative Ilhan Omar, a Minnesota Democrat, tweeted, referring to a comment from Ted Lieu, a California Democrat in the U.S. House of Representatives.

Democracies like India should not be engaging in a communications blackout that has lasted over three weeks. We need de-escalation, not the hiding of what's happening," Mr. Lieu had said on Twitter, referring to a tweet from Representative Don Boyer, a Virginia Democrat.

The number of lawmakers commenting on Kashmir possibly increase when the Congress, which is in recess, reconvenes in September.

Imran Khan's Op-Ed On Friday, Pakistan PM Imran Khan wrote an Op-Ed in the New York Times saying, "If the world does nothing to

stop the Indian assault on Kashmir and its people, there will be consequences for the whole world as two nuclear-armed States get ever closer to a direct military confrontation." He spoke about Mr. Modi's political ideology and background, the RSS and former RSS leader M.S. Golwalkar's admiration for Hitler and Mussolini.
