PMO Asks States to **Curb Fake ITC Claims**

New Delhi: A day after the GST Council set up a committee to identify measures to augment revenue from goods and services tax collection, the Centre Friday asked states to take steps to curb rising fake input tax credit claim cases

The Prime Minister's Office (PMO) on Friday took stock of the issues impacting revenue collection and asked states for increasing compliance and use data to nab evaders.

"States have been asked to take steps to be more vigilant of the fake input tax credit (ITC) claims and take steps to improve compliance," a government official, who attended the mee-

ting, said.

Another official said the emphasis was on extensive use of data provided to the states, especially in cases that were being red flagged.

The government, which restricted ITC credit to 20% without invoices on Thursday, could further reduce it, said one of the officials quoted above. "It has been suggested that it should be further brought down," the official said.

India's Crorepati Club Continues to Swell, 97,689 Disclose Income Above ₹1 Crore

New Delhi: India's crorepati club has swelled, with as many as 97,689 showing incomes above ₹1 crore in assessment year 2018-19, according to data from the Income Tax Department, released on Friday. This is 20% growth from the year before, when the number was 81,344.

Data from bank deposits made during the period were used to nab those who were not declaring true incomes, which the department claims led to increase in compliance. About 6.21 crore returns were filed up to December 2018. These included returns for past assessment years that taxpayers filed to comply.

As many as 2,085 individuals declared income from house property above Rs 1 crore in assessment year 2018-19. There is a substantial jump in individuals declaring long-term capital gains of over a crore - to 8,629 individuals against 6,750 in AY

In the case of firms, the number of those declaring income above Rs 1 lakh is taxed at 5% and that above crore rose to 17,320 in AY 2018-19 from 12,990 the year before.

India Wants Data Localisation in RCEP for Security Interests

New Delhi: India has proposed locating computing facilities inside the country if it is meant to protect its essential security interests and national interests at the the ongoing negotiations of the proposed Regional Comprehensive Economic Partnership (RCEP) trade agreement.

However, in the financial services chapter of the agreement, India is learnt to have agreed to financial data transfer in talks held in Vietnam in late September. It is believed to have agreed that financial services companies will be allowed to move and store data of Indians abroad.

The proposal is crucial as the Reserve Bank of India's (RBI) in its April 2018 notification mandated "all system providers shall ensure that the entire data relating to payment systems operated by them are stored in a system only in India". 
