


THE BJP has pushed for conferring the Bharat Ratna on Hindutva ideologue Vinayak Damodar Savarkar, popularly known as Veer Savarkar, in its manifesto for the Maharashtra Assembly elections released on Tuesday.

The party has also sought the honour for social reformers Iyotirao Govindrao Phule and Savitribai Phule.

"Mahatma Jyotiba Phule, Krantijyoti Savitribai Phule ani Swatantrata Veer Savarkar yancha Bharat Ratna gaurav vhawa ya sathi prayatna karu (We will strive to honour Mahatma Jyotiba Phule, Krantijyoti Savitribai Phule and Swatantrata Veer Savarkar with the Bharat Ratna)," says the manifesto.

"Savarkar was a great revolutionary and freedom fighter... Why should we look at such great persons with a narrow political prism. Let the nation unite and graciously bestow the award which he truly deserves," said Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis.

Criticising the BJP, Congress spokesperson Manish Tewari said: "On the 150th birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi, if this government considers any such thing, than all I want to say is that God save this country."



Son watched as man died in police custody, three cops suspended

ON SUNDAY evening, Pradeep Tomar (35) left home in Uttar Pradesh's Pilkhua telling his wife Rajni that his younger brother's motorcycle had a tyre puncture, and that he would be home soon after helping out. Tomar took his 11-year-old son along. He never returned.

He died hours later while in police custody after he was allegedly assaulted by several policemen, who has detained him for questioning in a murder case. According to his son, who witnessed the assault, Tomar was kicked, punched, hit with planks of wood, given electric shocks and pierced with a screwdriver

'Under stress', three PMC Bank depositors die within 24 hours

OVER THREE weeks after the RBI moved against PMC Bank for various irregularities, and imposed a curb on withdrawals, three of the cooperative bank's account-holders, including a 51-year-old who had lost his job with the defunct Jet Airways in April, died over the last 24 hours in Mumbai.

Two of the deaths have been attributed to heart attacks with families and friends claiming that they were under "severe stress". The third death was that of a 39-year-old doctor, who was "suffering from depression" and committed suicide, police said. Former Jet Airways senior




