## GREETING PEOPLE

- Good Night: ఆ రోజుకి వీడ్కోలు చెప్పుకోటానికి "Good Night" వాడతాం. రాత్రి 7 గంటలకైనా లేదా12 గంటలకైనా.
- Good Day: German word, "Guten Tag" ie. good day చాలా easy and convenient. రోజులో ఎప్పుడు కలుసుకున్నా, విడిపోతున్నా, Good Day చెప్పుకోవచ్చు.
- Bye: ఇది కొంచెం informal. Friends మధ్య చెప్పు కోవచ్చు. కానీ పెద్ద వాళ్లతో మాట్లాడేటప్పుడు దీన్ని వాడటం avoid చేయాలి. దానికి బదులు, "I take leave, sir" అనాలి. కొంత మంది మరీ వ్యవహారికంగా (colloquial m), "OK, I will push off!" అంటుంటారు. This is used to rudely tell someone to go away. Also, people say, "I'd better push off; I have got work to do." అంటే "ఇక నన్ను వదిలెయ్, నాకు పని ఉంది. బయట పడుతున్నాను" అని దీని అర్థం.


