



AHEAD OF the upcoming Supreme Court verdict in the Janmabhoomi-Babri Masjid title suit case, two senior Congress leaders, former Union minister Jitin Prasada and former Uttarakhand chief minister Harish Rawat, have said that they want to see a Ram temple built in Ayodhya, but added the apex court verdict would be supreme and should be ac-

The remarks by Rawat and Prasada, members of the **Congress Working Committee** (CWC), come at a time when the Congress has begun discussions to craft its response to the verdict. In audio clip, kin of Tiwari murder accused 'plead with him to return'

AN AUDIO clip has surfaced in Gujarat, in which the wife and father of Ashfaq Shaikh, one of the two men accused of murdering Kamlesh Tiwari, are purportedly pleading with him to return home, saying they have met the



home on October 18

The 1.55-minute clip of the purported conversation appears

INX case: Karnataka skills chief quits after chargesheet

DEEPTIMANTIWARY NEW DELHI, OCTOBER 26

FORMER SECRETARY of the Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises, Anup K Pujari, who was recently chargesheeted by the CBI in the INX Media case, has resigned from his current job as chairman, Karnataka Skill Development

Pujari has said that he has learnt through the media that he has been chargesheeted by the CBI in the case and thus his continuation in the post would not be "in conformity with the best traditions of the civil services" and that it may "cause undue embarrassment to the government".
