# Man celebrates his birthday after killing student, arrested

His brother-in-law has also been nabbed in connection with the case: police

A 35-year-old man has been arrested for allegedly killing his student in north-east Delhi's Karawal Nagar, the police said on Saturday.

DCP Deputy Commissioner of Police (North-East) Ved Prakash Surya said that Naushad Ali (35) and his brother-in-law Rafiq alias Samir (28) had dumped the body in a drain.

On September 29, at 7.45 a.m., a PCR call was received regarding a body found floating in a drain near Sardar Patel School, the police said. On reaching the spot, the police took the decomposed body of a woman aged around 25 years to Guru Teg Bahadur Hospital for postmortem. A case on charges of murder and causing the disappearance of evidence was registered, an officer said.

Deputy Commissioner of Police (Rohini) S.D Mishra said Amit Gaur, an MBA, and his wife Renu (34), are both residents of Bhajanpura.

The police said they received a complaint from the owners of a firm, which deals in coated fabric in Rithala, stating that their Amit quit recently without handing over the charge to anyone.

The company then employed another accountant and while going through the financial records, they saw a long list of debtors and contacted them.

### Child rights panel member latest snatching victim

'Officer said such incidents occur regularly'

A member of the Delhi Commission for Protection of Child Rights (DCPCR) became the recent victim of snatching near her residence in Rohini's Prashant Vihar on Friday morning.

Jyoti Rathee said at 9.15 a.m., she was returning to her apartment on her scooty when two bike-borne men tried to snatch her gold chain with a locket. She also alleged that there were two more men, whom she suspects to be part of the same

Rathee said she thought that the accused were asking for directions. When the incident happened, the accused pushed her but she held onto the locket. The accused managed to snatch the chain but the locket remained with her. She has sustained minor injuries on her hand and neck.

Ms. Rathee immediately

went to a police station to lodge a complaint but was allegedly told by an officer that such incidents occur regularly and registered an e-FIR in the matter under Section 379 (punishment for theft) of the IPC. She claims to have given the officer a CCTV footage of the incident. DCP (Rohini) S.D. Mishra said Ms. Rathee's statement has been recorded and sections of robbery have been added. "Disciplinary action is being taken against the officer who attended the complainant at the police station and registered e-FIR," he said. The victim said incidents of snatchings and robberies are on a rise in the area and there are no police patrolling vans.

### Arrested for snatching, accused confess to murder

Victim's body found in Yamuna Khadar

Six persons were arrested for allegedly killing their friend over personal enmity in Shahdara's Geeta Colony, the police said on Saturday.

The accused were initially arrested for their involvement in cases of robbery and snatching but allegedly confessed to the murder, they said.

The police said the local staff of Geeta Colony police station was informed that a few boys were sitting in a park near SDM office and are suspected to have been involved in cases of robbery and snatching. On reaching the spot, they conducted a search when a loaded countrvmade with live cartridge was recovered from the possession of one of the accused person.

While being interrogated on their previous involvements, one of the accused disclosed about killing a man along with his associates on Sunday night. He also said they later dumped the body at Yamuna Khadar, a senior officer said.

On their instance, a decomposed body was recovered from Yamuna Khadar following which a murder case was registered at Geeta Colony police station. The deceased was missing from his home and no complaint was filed by his family members, they said.

During invetsigation, two more persons were arrested; one of who disclosed that he had personal enmity with deceased due to which he planned the killing with his associates on September

Additional Sessions Judge Gorakh Nath Pandey dismissed his appeal, saying that he failed to rebut the presumption that he had issued a cheque to the complainant to repay a loan of ₹7 lakh.

The convict was a friend of the complainant and had taken the loan for a short period at 5% interest per year. At the time of the transfer of the loan, the convict had issued a cheque for

### Two phone snatchers held after police encounter

Two alleged mobile phone snatchers were arrested here after an exchange of gunfire with police, an official said on Saturday.

The accused were held around 11.30 p.m. on Friday after an encounter near Sandeep Paper Mill in Sector 6, the police said.

Both the accused are residents of Pandav Nagar in Delhi and multiple snatched mobile phones were recovered from their possession, a police spokesperson said.

Nobody was injured in the gunfight but the duo arrested and their illegal firearms along with ammuniseized," spokesperson said.

**Multiple cases** 

The official said Rajveer Singh and Suraj Kumar were behind at least nine recent incidents of mobile snatching in the area and have multiple criminal cases, including those registered against them under the Arms Act and sections of the Indian Penal Code for attempted murder.

A fresh case has been registered against them and the accused have been remanded in judicial custody by a local court, the spokesperson said. In a separate case on Fri-

day afternoon, the Noida Police had arrested a snatcher fleeing with his accomplice on a motorcycle after snatching a woman's gold chain.
