Earlier Monday, an 18year-old student and a 38year-old woman became the first to be prosecuted under the mask ban, which is punishable by up to a year in prison and a Detained early Saturday

shortly after the ban took effect the two were also charged with taking part in an unlawful assembly, which carries a heavier penalty of up to five years in jail. They were both released on bail pending trial.

"I am wearing a mask to come here today ... This is a form of silent protest," said 16year-old student Bao Yeung, who was among a large group of supporters outside the court.

Tĥe protests were sparked by a now-shelved bill that would have allowed some criminal suspects to be sent to mainland China for trial but have since morphed into a larger anti-government movement. Protesters are upset at what they say is Beijing's increasing influence over the former British colony, which was promised a high level of autonomy when it returned to Chinese rule in 1997. AP
