

A NEW academic paper — written by Santosh Mehrotra and Jajati K Parida and published by the Centre of Sustainable Employment at the Azim Premji University on Thursday — has formally concluded that the total employment in India declined between 2011-12 and 2017-18.

This is the first time such a decline has been recorded in independent India's history.

While this point has been made by the same authors as well as some others, such as Himanshu of Jawaharlal Nehru University, this is the first formal paper to this effect. According to Mehrotra and Parida, the "total employment during 2011-12 and 2017-18 declined by 9 million. This happened for the first time in India's history".

Mehrotra is Professor of Economics at Jawaharlal Nehru University while Parida teaches at the Central University of Punjab.

Employment falls first time — by 9 million: Study

WIDE VARIATIONS IN EMPLOYMENT ESTIMATES

This result is in stark contrast to the recent study by Laveesh Bhandari and Amaresh Dubey, which was commissioned by the Economic Advisory Council to the Prime Minister, that claimed that total employment grew from 433 million in 2011-12 to 457 million in 2017-18.

Mehrotra and Parida, however, claim that employment fell from 474 million in 2011-12 to 465 million in 2017-18. According to Himanshu's opinion piece in Mint on August 1 he has not yet written a formal paper on this issue — the total employment fell from 472.5 million in 2011-12 to an even more astounding 457 million a fall of over 15 million over the six years. In other words, close to 2.6 million jobs were lost every year between 2011-12 and 2017-18.

On the face of it, (see table) these stark contrasts — there is a difference of 40 million in the estimates for 2011-12 given by Bhandari and Dubey on the one hand and Mehrotra and Parida and Himanshu on the other are surprising because the underlying data for all these studies is the same — the National Sample Survey Organisation's **Employment-Unemployment** Surveys for 2004-05 and 2011-12, and PLFS 2017-18. In other words, the ratios of employment and unemployment used by all academics are the same, but the absolute numbers differ.

While the academics figure out why they differ — neither side has read the other side's paper as vet — there are two possible reasons.

One is the choice of the estimate for the total population of the country that is used to arrive at the total employment number. A higher population estimate used would yield a higher employment estimate. Bhandari and Dubey use 1.36 billion as India's population for 2017-18. Mehrotra and Parida use 1.35 billion and say they do so to arrive at estimates that do not attract criticism for being unnecessarily low. The World Bank's number for 2017-18 is lower at 1.33 billion. Himanshu, however, uses the number provided in the government's official GDP data — and this is con-

siderably lower at 1.31 billion.

not yet released the population projections based on Census 2011. They should have been released in 2016 as per the past norm. The second reason for the difference between Bhandari and Dubey's estimate and the rest is that the former have only used "principal status" of employment while leaving out the "subsidiary status". In essence, principal status

checks if a person was employed for more than 182 days in the 365 days preceding the survey while subsidiary status checks if a person was employed for at least 30 days in the past year. Choosing only principal status would thus inadequately estimate both employment and unemployment. Since a fair amount of employment in India is seasonal — for example, brick-making doesn't happen during monsoon and many women tend to work for short periods aligned to the demand in agriculture etc. — the norm is to map both principal and subsidiary status.

In a statement, Ravi Shankar Prasad, Union Minister for Law and Justice, Communications, Electronics & Information Technology, said: "Government of India is committed to protecting privacy of all Indian citizens. Government agencies have a well established protocol for interception, which includes sanction and supervision from highly ranked officials in central and state governments, for clear stated reasons in national interest."

Responding to this, a WhatsApp spokesperson said: "We agree with the Government of India's strong statement about the need to safeguard the privacy of all Indian citizens. That is why we have taken this strong action to hold cyber attackers accountable and why WhatsApp is so committed to the protection of all user messages through the product we provide."

Prasad also took a swipe at the Congress which targeted the government over WhatsApp's disclosure: "Those trying to make political capital out of it need to be

gently reminded about the bugging incident in the office of the then eminent Finance Minister Pranab Mukherjee during UPA regime. Also a gentle reminder of the spying over the then Army Chief Gen. VK Singh. These are instances of breach of privacy of highly reputed individuals, for personal whims and fancies of a family."

The Ministry of Home Affairs, in a statement, said "attempts to malign the Government of India for the reported breach are completely misleading". Underlining that the "Government of India is committed to protect the fundamental rights of Indian citizens, including the right to privacy" and that it "operates strictly as per provisions of law and laid down protocols", the MHA said: "There are adequate safeguards to ensure that no innocent citizen is harassed or his privacy breached. Strict action will be taken against those who are found guilty of violating any provision of law.'

Meanwhile, in response to an RTI application dated October 23 by one Saurav Das who asked the MHA whether the government had purchased or given a purchase order for the Pegasus spyware, the Ministry's Cyber and Information Security Thursday stated that "no such information is available with the undersigned CPIO (Central Public Information Officer)".

Congress MP Shashi Tharoor, chairman of the Parliamentary Standing Committee on Information Technology, said the panel will take up the surveillance matter and seek clarifications from the government. "I am extremely concerned about this development and am sure the Parliamentary Committee on Information Technology would share my concerns... I intend to consult other members by email on the matter. In any case, cybersecurity is a major issue on our agenda and we are definitely going to take this up under that rubric. Of course, we will be seeking clarifications from the government." he said.

His party went on the offensive, seeking answers from the government. In a press release, Randeep Singh Surjewala, AICC communications in-charge, said the government and the minister must explain who "purchased and deployed" the spyware, who authorised it and what action will be taken. He also urged the Supreme Court to take suo motu cognizance and "conduct a courtmonitored inquiry".

Going further, in coming years, the university will also launch various schools & centres to cater to the needs of the entire value chain of the maritime sector.

School of Maritime Management: This school would offer programs focused on management and commercial aspects of maritime sector such as Shipping Management, Port Operations, Ship Finance, Transportation and Logistics Management.

School of Marine Technology: This school would offer programs focused on engineering, science and technology related aspects of the maritime sector such as Marine Engineering, Naval Architecture, Naval Sciences etc.

School of Liberal Arts & Social Sciences: This school would offer programs focused on liberal arts and social sciences – maritime history, ecology etc.

Centre of Continuing Education: This centre would offer Continuing Education programs for professionals in the maritime sector.

Centre for Faculty Development: This centre will cater to needs of faculty development in maritime education.

The maritime industry has greatly contributed to enhance country's competitive position in the global trade with approximately 95% of India's trade by volume and 70% by value moved by sea. Hence, the development and growth of the maritime industry is important as it plays a vital role in the country's overall economic development. Various key initiatives by the Government of India are expected to generate several job opportunities related to ship building, repairing and maintenance, shipping, dredging, goods forwarding and clearing related activities. The growth of overall maritime industry would also result in manpower requirement for maritime services like maritime law, maritime finance, maritime consultancy, maritime technical assistance, R&D centers etc.





PRIVATE BUSES, which are being temporarily roped in to augment public transport, are likely to run in two shifts during the oddeven policy, which will be in force from November 4 to 15. The associations informed the Delhi government Thursday that they will be unable to lease their vehicles for the entire day during the 12-day period.

During a meeting chaired by Transport Minister Kailash Gahlot, officials said that so far, around 180 private bus operators have submitted applications offering their services during oddeven. The Delhi Cabinet has cleared a proposal to hire 2,000 private buses. "The associations informed the government that they will be able to extend their services between 8.30 am-12.30 pm and 3.30 pm-8.30 pm. The window in between is required to ferry school students. Buses can be offered through the day only if schools remain closed dur-

'75% crop harvested, farm fires to reduce in Punjab'

MALLICA JOSHI NEW DELHI, OCTOBER 31

DIRECTIONS TO sow paddy a week earlier than last year could help Delhi beat another pollution peak owing to crop residue burning in Punjab. According to KS Pannu, agriculture secretary. Punjab government, the peak number of fires has already been reached earlier this week and a large percentage of grain has also arrived at purchase centres.

Data collected by NASA's MODIS tool between 2012 and 2019 shows that the number of fires usually sees a spike in the first week of November. So far this year, the number of fires in the fields of Punjab has already exceeded those recorded last year. The worst year in the recent past was 2016. "We had advanced the date of sowing by a week this year. As a result, around 75% of the paddy crop has already been harvested and around 66% has arrived at mandis," said Pannu.

According to NASA's data, most of the fires this year are concentrated in Punjab. The highest number of fires in the state were recorded, so far, on Wednesday at 3,135. In 2018, till

PAMPOSH ENCLAVE

How Dal Lake lotus gave colony for Kashmiri Pandits its name

NEW DELHI, OCTOBER 31 AN EFFORT to rebuild a community far away from home in the

1950s and 1960s lent an unfamiliar name, in an unfamiliar language, to a residential colony in the heart of Delhi — Pamposh Enclave. As the first wave of Kashmiri Pandits who migrated to the

capital in the late 1940s worked towards building their first community here, they decided to name it after the lotus which grows in the Dal Lake, or the pamposh in Kashmiri. Dr B B Dhar, a resident of the

area and president of the

Kashmir Education Culture and Science Society, recalled how the idea of the enclave was conceived. "By the late 1940s, there was a good number of Kashmir Brahmins who had moved out of the state and begun settling in different parts of Delhi. Most of them took up lower level government jobs, in the capacity of clerks and likewise, and were scattered around the city in Lajpat Nagar, Karol Bagh, RK Puram and other Government of India colonies. A group of these new settlers began to meet in order to discuss getting their own place, a place for the community. They approached the central government, which was sympathetic," Dhar said.

STREET WISE STORIES BEHIND OUR **ROAD NAMES**

This stretch of then-forested land to the Southeast of the capital centre was allotted to a newly created Kashmiri cooperative housing society in the late 1950s, and the process of allotting plots to families began in 1961.

Then remained the task of giving this newly created residential area a name.

A name chosen by members of the community, Pamposh was different from names of many post-Partition refugee colonies which were named by the government after heroes of the new nation, such as Lajpat Nagar, Malviya Nagar, Jawahar Nagar, Patel Nagar, Subhash Nagar, and so on.

The settlers did not choose to commemorate a personality as was common with Delhi's street and locality names, but instead decided on an emotive symbol.

"Our forefathers in the general council of the cooperative

society considered multiple options. It was significant — it was to be a mini Kashmir, the first colony to be set up after the migration began. They ultimately chose to name it after the lotus which holds meaning for all Kashmiris," said Arun Shalia one of the oldest residents of the area. "It is a symbol of home for

Kashmiris. It grows in our lakes. Even more significant than the flower is what is beneath it — the nadru or the lotus stem which is used in our cuisine and is a source of livelihood for many The blooming of the lotus is also symbolic of how our forefathers wanted the community to grow in this new home," Dhar said.

Inaugurating new HQ, Shah calls for image makeover of police

INAUGURATING THE new Delhi Police headquarters at Jai Singh Road Thursday, Union Home Minister Amit Shah asked the force to be proactive and responsive towards redressing grievances of the public.

Stating that the Narendra Modi government is trying to make people understand the challenges that police face every day, Shah said: "To make the 'law and order' system accessible to all, police must be sensitised and must help the public with their grievances. Also, we (public) need to change our perception and understand the sacrifices the police make for us since they work day and night to protect us."

Cautioning them that new buildings do not guarantee a reformed police force, he stressed on the need to change the image of police: "It can be achieved only by transforming the spirit of policing towards being publicservice oriented. Only then will the public image improve and the efforts the force is making achieve the intended positive results."

Stating that internal security is the Modi government's top priority, Shah said: "We have undertaken a lot of work to improve security at the borders, and cracked down on fake notes." He also said security forces are working diligently towards accomplishing it.

He congratulated the Delhi Police for its new headquarters and said, "Finally, after 70 years, they got their own house. It was delayed but it happened for good." He added that the inauguration could not have hap-

pened on a more auspicious day than the birth anniversary of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, the country's first home minister and the 'Iron Man of India'.

He paid tribute to Delhi Police personnel who lost their lives in the 2001 Parliament attack and were conferred the Kirti Chakra, and to inspector Mohan Chand Sharma who was killed during the 2008 Batla House encounter.

"The Modi government has developed the National Police Memorial in New Delhi, which chronicles the sacrifices of over 34,000 officers and jawans who laid down their lives for the country," he said, and urged the public to visit the memorial and witness the challenges faced by police forces and sacrifices made by them in securing the nation.

Talking about the importance of the police in the nation's progress, Shah said that a stable law and order situation is most important for economic growth and social development in the country. He observed that the police is perpetually projected in

a negative light in popular media, but the sacrifices made round-the-clock by officers and jawans to ensure the safety of citizens are seldom highlighted.

"Such a kind of negative projection demoralises our police force. The public image of police needs to change," he said.

On the contribution of Sardar Patel in national integration, Shah said he was known for his actions, more than his words, and for integrating over 550 princely states at the time of Independence. "Sardar Patel accomplished a near-impossible task of surmounting tough challenges in a short time and creating a united India that we are proud of today," he said.

Delhi Police Commissioner Amulya Patnaik said: "The new police headquarters has been built in a public-private partnership mode at a cost of Rs 286 crore. It is spread over an area of eight acres."

Call to food delivery JNUSU protest against admin service lands woman continues — with office orders on run in police net

These acts constitute a serious breach of the democratic ethos of the university..."

"... This is an act of indiscipline and misconduct. For due process of natural justice, your reply should reach the competent authority latest by November 4, failing which it will be presumed that you have nothing to say in your defence and the competent authority will be free to take appropriate

action against you," it added.

A similar office order was issued against Dean of Students Umesh Kadam, declaring him "out of bounds".

"Anyone giving shelter to Mr Umesh Ashok Kadam in any premises of the university shall be considered to be party to (his) offences. If he has to come to JNU for any academic purpose, he has to seek official permission from the office of the JNUSU, 10 days prior to the visit," it read.

Kadam and V-C M Jagadesh Kumar did not respond to calls and texts by *The Indian Express*. Kadam had earlier called the

notice insulting. Sharing a photo of the notice, he tweeted, "This is how Aishe Ghosh (JNUSU president) is insulting, threatening and defaming me in public space, I am requesting the Ministry of Social Justice and re-appealing to Vasant Kunj North police to take immediate action against her for instigating and holding me hostage even in the ambulance.

On Monday, the JNU administration claimed the union did not allow Kadam to leave the hostel committee meeting despite health issues. However, JNUSU claimed Kadam "faked health issues" to avoid discussion.

BJP supporters also showed up at the same time, prompting police to create a buffer between the two sides. The local SDM later filed an application with the SDMC seeking permission, which granted conditional approval and said the

BJPMPMeenakshi Lekhi said: "Instead of misleading local citizens and vitiating the atmosphere, AAP should follow legal process." CM Kejriwal tweeted: "To ensure devotees don't have to go too far from their homes...we have increased the number of ghats from 72 to 1,108...The Delhi government is making grand arrangements at all ghats."



The conference will see participation from Pakistan, and a presentation will be made by the FATF. Sources said India is likely to raise the issue of killing of civilians in Kashmir by Pakistan-sponsored terrorists.

HC asks AIIMS to form medical board for opinion on Chidambaram health

It sought a report by Friday on whether the senior Congress leader needs to be admitted to the hospital.


Justice Suresh Kumar Kait said that Hyderabad-based gastroenterologist Nageshwar Reddy, who has been treating Chidambaram (74), be included in the board.

The court was hearing Chidambaram's plea for six-day interim bail to enable him to get examined by Reddy, his regular doctor, at the Asian Institute of Gastroenterology (AIG) in

Hyderabad. Asking the AIIMS director to constitute the board by 4 pm, the judge said it should give its opinion especially on whether the Congress leader needs to be in sterile environment at the hospital. It also made clear that the board will meet at 7 pm, and if Reddy is unable to reach from Hyderabad, the board should sit

on Friday at 10 am. The court will hear the matter

Senior advocate Kapil Sibal insisted that Chidambaram be shifted from Tihar jail to a private ward in AIIMS on Thursday. But Mehta said the doctors who examined the leader on Wednesday did not advise admitting him to hospital.

Annoved over Mehta's response, Sibal said he is withdrawing the plea and he was "surprised that this government does not want to give a sterile environment to a person".

PM: Think of administrative services as service for poor

PRIME MINISTER Narendra Modi on Thursday urged civil service officials not to think of the administrative services as a career, but as a service for the poor. Referring to Mahatma Gandhi's principle that any service should reach the last man standing, Modi urged officers to be "proactive and progressive".

He was addressing a gathering of probationary civil services officers who had undergone a ioint conference titled 'Aarambh' in Gujarat's Kevadia for over a week. The Prime Minister was visiting Kevadia as part of the Rashtriya Ekta Diwas or National Unity Day celebrations.

With the Statue of Unity the giant statue of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel which also features in the logo of 'Aarambh', in the backdrop — Modi described the training conference as a "unique, integrated" course that brings together all civil services

"So far, we have seen that some officers train in Mussoorie, some in Hyderabad. This is the first time that you all have gath-

ered in an integrated programme and been exposed to similar experts from the field of economics, administration and other important fields. This is truly the beginning of an integrated programme for the administrative services," the Prime Minister said.

The video of his speech was put out by the BJP on its social media handle. Modi exhorted the probationary officers not to view the civil services as a career but draw inspiration from the works of Sardar Patel and Mahatma Gandhi to ensure development in their respective areas.

"You must come into this

service to the people. It is important to ensure that people do not think of you as officers sitting behind closed doors. Interacting with people and hearing them is extremely important. No one expects you to have an instant solution to problems but it is important to step into the field and check up on areas," he said, quoting the example of Sardar Patel's

Ahmedabad Municipality. He also advised officials to follow Mahatma Gandhi's principle of 'antyodaya'.

"We must remember what Gandhi ji has said, that 'any benefit given to the society must truly reach the last of the people'. You must always weigh each of your decisions on two parameters — whether it meets the aspirations and hopes of those people on the last rungs of society, and whether it meets the principles of unity and the sovereignty of the country. Your signatures can make a lot of difference on paper," he said.

Emphasising on the need to reach out to people, Modi also laid importance on clearing the image of the bureaucracy as being "unapproachable".

Modi to visit Thailand from Nov 2-4 to attend three summits

PRIME MINISTER Narendra Modi will visit Thailand from November 2-4, during which he will attend the ASEAN-India, East Asia and Regional Comprehensive Economic Partnership (RCEP) summits, the Ministry of External Affairs announced on Thursday.

PM Modi will be visiting Bangkok at the invitation of Thai Prime Minister Prayut Chan-ocha, Secretary (East) Vijay Thakur Singh said at a media briefing. The Prime Minister will attend the 16th ASEAN-India summit, the 14th East Asia Summit and third RCEP summit and related events, she said. Negotiations for resolving

outstanding issues on RCEP are going on in Bangkok, she said, adding the leaders will review the state of negotiations at the summit. The RCEP bloc comprises 10 ASEAN group members (Brunei, Cambodia, Indonesia, Malaysia, Myanmar, Singapore, Thailand, the Philippines, Laos and Vietnam) and their six FTA partners

In touch with BJP, Cong & NCP: Uddhav

VISHWAS WAGHMODE MUMBAI, OCTOBER 31

INSISTING ON an "equal power sharing" formula with the BJP for government formation in Maharashtra, Shiv Sena chief Uddhav Thackeray on Thursday upped the ante by declaring that he was in touch with Congress and NCP as well, appearing to signal that he was prepared to explore other options.

The Indian Express learnt from Sena functionaries and legislators present at a meeting called to elect the party's legislative leader that Uddhav said he wants "equal power sharing", including for the CM's post, "as was decided before the Lok Sabha polls" with BJP.

"The equal power sharing formula was decided before Lok Sabha polls between me, (BJP national president) Amit Shah and Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis. We want things to be as was decided and nothing more than that," Uddhav said at the meeting.

The Sena chief also remarked that no one could make a "permanent claim" on the CM chair. "I am in touch with BJP, Congress and NCP," said Uddhav.

As if to drive the point home, on Thursday evening, Sena leader and MPSanjay Raut met NCP chief Sharad Pawar. Describing it as "courtesy visit", Raut told The *Indian Express*, "I keep meeting Pawarsaheb... This time, I went to greet him on Diwali."

Asked whether the Sena was looking for support from the NCP to form the government, Raut refused to divulge the nature of discussions between the two. He, however, said: "I think our party chief has already made things clear... he has clearly said that all options are open..."

On senior Congress leader Prithviraj Chavan's remarks that the party was waiting for a proposal from the Sena, Raut said Uddhav had already clarified who he was in touch with.

At the meeting on Thursday, Uddhav is also said to have expressed his displeasure over Fadnavis' remarks that no equal power sharing formula was decided ahead of the Lok Sabha polls

and asked Sena legislators to watch a video of the chief minister addressing the media in February after forging the alliance with Sena. "He can be seen talking about equal power sharing formula. We just want them to keep their word," said Uddhav.

A senior leader said the BJP was trying to convey the impression that the Sena chief was lying "It is not acceptable to us. How car they show our leader in bad light? So, Uddhav clearly said that the Sena has other options open, including that of the NCP and the Congress."

Meanwhile, an editorial in Sena mouthpiece Saamana said that Fadnavis publicly used the word "equal power sharing" while addressing the media before the Lok Sabha polls. "Now, if anybody is saying that the CM post was not included, then we need to write new lessons of political science. Equal power sharing includes all," it said.

It added that the BJP broke the alliance with Sena after its victory in the 2014 Lok Sabha polls under the leadership of Narendra Modi "Now, the BJP has started another chapter after getting a similar victory in 2019, but we will not fall

for it," the editorial said. "If anybody feels that the CM post is not a seat of power or it is not possible to share it, why is everyone across the country after such a non-significant post?"

Addressing a gathering after

presenting the Indira Gandhi Award for National Integration to noted environmentalist Chandi Prasad Bhatt, Sonia said national integration was one of Indira Gandhi's many passions.

"But unlike those in the ruling establishment now, she did not equate unity with uniformity,"

Sonia said.

Sonia said the former Prime Minister was deeply conscious

of India's many diversities and profoundly sensitive to its cultural traditions. "She was fiercely wedded to strengthening the bonds of political and cultural unity. She believed in accommodating, respecting and celebrating our many diversities. She also recognised that without just economic and social policies that actively promoted equity and inclusiveness, India could not develop and prosper. Her vision of national integration was all-encompassing, helping the disadvantaged, and ensuring that no section of Indian society was excluded on the basis of caste or creed," Sonia said.

"The fundamental assumptions that guided our freedom struggle and inspired our country after independence are now

being called into question. Today, we see rising intolerance, rising violence. A skewed vision of our history and society is being imposed along with falsehood and unscientific ideas. All this is the antithesis of the liberal, secular and democratic foundations of our country," she

Speaking on the occasion, former Prime Minister Manmohan Singh said Bhatt's entire life has been dedicated to public causes. "This is the year when we are celebrating Gandhi ji's 150th birth centenary. And I am inclined to believe that the Mahatma would be pleased that this year the award is going to a man who made us take note of the incipient crisis of climate change," he said.

New rules final assault to decimate RTI: Congress chief

DAYS AFTER the government notified new RTI rules reducing the tenure of central and state information commissioners from five to three years and lowering their ranks, Congress president Sonia Gandhi Thursday termed the changes as the BJP government's

"final assault to decimate RTI".

Sonia said the changes will "diminish" the office of the Information Commissioner, leaving it "at the mercy of the very government it is required to hold accountable". The Congress chief said the Modi government has always viewed RTI as an "obstacle to enforcing their majoritarian agenda without being held accountable to people".

"The BJP government has now launched its final assault to decimate RTI. To further erode and dilute its effectiveness, the Modi government has passed amendments which diminish the office of the Information Commissioner..." she said in a statement.

Sonia said the term of the Information Commissioners was fixed for five years under the 2005 law to ensure there was no executive interference. "Any official who allows the release of information against the government can now be swiftly removed or simply not continued in office This will have a chilling effect on all Information Commissioners.. By reducing the benefits for these important posts, the government has ensured no senior self-respecting official would agree to work under such monitored circumstances," she said.

CPI leader Gurudas Dasgupta dies at 83



ONE OF the prominent faces of trade union movements in the country, veteran CPI leader and former MP Gurudas Dasgupta died in Kolkata on Thursday following a prolonged illness. He was 83 and is survived by his wife and daughter.

West Bengal CPI secretary Swapan Banerjee announced his death in the morning. "He (Dasgupta) died at his home in Kolkata at 6 am. He was suffering from lung cancer for quite tional executive council of the CPI," said Banerjee. Earlier, Dasgupta was admit-

ted to Tata Medical Centre where he was kept on the ventilator for some time. On Monday, he was released from the hospital and brought home.

A five-term parliamentarian since 1985, Dasgupta was elected to the Rajya Sabha three times and twice to the Lok Sabha from West Bengal. He was born on November 3, 1936, in Barishal district (now in Bangladesh) of undivided Bengal, After partition, he along with his parents and siblings

Stay calm, irrespective of SC order: RSS to cadres

'Mob lynchings are not just happening in Jharkhand... should not be made political agenda'

Iharkhand Chief Minister **RAGHUBAR DAS** speaks to **ABHISHEK ANGAD** on incidents of lynching and the upcoming state polls. Excerpts:

During our reportage, we found out that the most vulnerable sections of the society are not getting the benefit of Central schemes.

All such schemes have been implemented as per the 2011 Census. I am aware of what you have mentioned. I frequently speak to people and it will be addressed. By 2022, nobody will be left homeless, but this will not happen quickly. It will take time.

You have said the government has focused on roads, electricity and water. At Maspera, Sundarpahari, in Godda, ill people are being carried to hospitals on cots because there is no road. Water scarcity has been the biggest problem of the state capital during summer. You once said you will provide 24x7 electricity, that has not

happened... A government needs at least 10 years to complete its work. I am not saying Ram Rajya has come. At Sundarpahari, the local MLA is from IMM. What did they do? On electricity, I was misquoted. I had said electricity will reach every village....it has reached 30 lakh more houses in the last five years compared to 39 lakh in the last 14 years...It will take time. Regarding water, we have started conservation. There is no scarcity of water, but it has to be managed well...

The government put thrust on Momentum Iharkhand. What is the total investment that came in?

Work worth Rs 72,000 crore is going on in sectors like power, food processing and textiles. In the coming years, Jharkhand will become a textile hub. Garments are being exported to European countries over the past two years. Now footwear will be manufactured in Jharkhand.

But how much is the business it is generating worth?

THE EXPRESS INTERVIEW

RAGHUBAR DAS **CHIEF MINISTER**

You think only if it is big business. My focus is on MSMEs because I have to end poverty and MSMEs are the spine of the economy.

You have created land banks where the government acquired uncultivated and common land to attract investment. Many have criticised this and said the tribals or villagers were not spoken to.

These are people who are antidevelopment and do not want growth of the poor. When I conduct choupals, I ask people did the government take the land? The answer is in the negative. It is the government's land. So, land mafia and anti-development people are having a stomach ache. People who took away land are now talking about land rights now. Look at the violation of Chotanagpur Tenancy Act and Santhal Pargana Tenancy Act by the Soren family.

Mob violence has become a nuisance in Iharkhand. Recently, a Christian tribal in Khunti and Tabrez Ansari in Saraikela, who was made to chant Jai Shri Ram, died. In the last three years, 21 deaths happened due to child-lifting rumours and on the suspicion of cow slaughter or beef possession.

Mob lynchings are not just happening in Jharkhand. Is it not happening in Delhi, Bihar or Congress-ruled states? First of all, this is wrong. Nobody has the right to take law in their hands. As for the 20-21 deaths, the dead were deranged people who were lynched on the suspicion that they were thieves. If you leave one or two incidents, maximum people who died were deranged. I am keeping a tab and have directed police and the administration to handle it effectively, but it should not be made a political agenda.

What about incidents where mob violence is driven by religious polarisation, such as the Tabrez Ansari case.

This should not happen and this is wrong. People should not see Hindus and Muslims in cases of lynching. This is being done by parties indulging in vote bank politics. If a Muslim dies, it becomes an issue...AAP came from Delhi to Saraikela to give Rs 5 lakh (in the Ansari case), how many other lynching victims' families have they reached out to? They are not pained by the lynching, they have to play vote bank politics.

The Aadhaar-based biometric authentication in PDS led to exclusion of many beneficiaries.

Now everyone has Aadhaar. We have also given directions that ration be given even if there is no biometric authentication.

What is your stand on NRC? People who are Bangladeshis

have to go. We will implement NRC.

What is your understanding of the political climate in Iharkhand after the results in **Maharashtra and Haryana** where the BJP could not achieve its target?

One cannot compare one state with the other. These states do not have 26 per cent tribals. We will aim high. We will definitely win 65 plus seats in the Assembly polls.

Since the unlawful act in case of content uploaded from India is committed from within India, a global injunction shall operate in respect of such content.

"In case of uploads which take place from outside India, the unlawful act would be the dissemination of such content in India, and thus in those cases the platforms may resort to geo-blocking, Justice Pratibha M Singh had said.

In MGNREGA plan, govt focus on water conservation

NEW DELHI, OCTOBER 31

IN VIEW of its ambitious target to provide

tapwater connections to all rural households by 2024, the government will now focus on source sustainability through river rejuvenation and water harvesting works under the MGNREGA scheme. The Ministry of Rural

Development has asked states to focus on works related to water conservation while preparing the MGNREGA labour budget for the 2020-21 financial year.

Issuing guidelines for planning works and preparation of labour budget under the MGNREGA, the ministry has said there should be a "special focus on water harvesting and water conservation, including river rejuvenation".

According to sources, special emphasis will be laid on water conservation in 2,129 identified rural blocks, 1,593 of which are water-stressed. In such blocks, the maximum amount of labour budget will be spent on management of natural resources, including water conservation.

Water conservation works will be taken up in the convergence with central governmentfunded schemes such as

DEPENDING ON objectives of the government of the day, MGNREGA, over the years, has seen convergence with the several schemes such as rural housing and sanitation. The focus on work related to natural resource management, particularly water conservation and river rejuvenation, is in the same direction. As the government is preparing to provide the tapwater connections to all rural households. there is again a need for MGN-REGA convergence with an emphasis on water harvesting to ensure source sustainability.

MP BJP leader: Children who eat eggs may turn into man-eaters

FORMER MADHYA Pradesh minister and Leader of the Opposition in the state Assembly Gopal Bhargav has courted controversy after he wondered aloud whether children who eat eggs will grow up to become "man-eaters".

Reacting to the state government's introduction of eggs in anganwadi meals, the senior BIP leader told reporters, "What can you expect from a malnourished government? Today it's offering eggs; later it may serve chicken and goats... If you offer them eggs from childhood, they will eat flesh when they grow up... they may turn into man-eaters."

In response, Congress leader Shobha Oza named BJP-ruled states where eggs are part of anganwadi meals and asked whether children there also ran the risk of turning into "maneaters". She also demanded that Bhargav be removed from the post of leader of the opposition.

The previous BJP government had not allowed eggs to be served. Former CM Shivraj Singh Chouhan had opposed the idea, saying there were other alternatives to eggs.

Report on Kashmir situation: 'Marked increase in psychological distress'

AN 11-MEMBER team comprising a mental health specialist, which visited Kashmir to understand the situation after the scrapping of the special status in Jammu and Kashmir, has said in its report that "there is a marked increase in psychological distress" in the region.

The report, 'Imprisoned Resistance: 5th August and its aftermath,' was released in the capital on Thursday.

Delhi-based psychiatrist Dr Amit Sen, who was part of the team and interacted with mental health specialists in the Valley, has said in the report that "widespread disruption of daily life across the state has had a profound impact

on the lives of children". The team, which also comprised human rights activists and legal experts, visited the Valley between September 28 and October 4.

"Grassroot workers are unable to refer children showing clear signs of trauma and abuse to more centralised facilities that are better equipped to deal with such complex cases due to the lack of transport and connectivity. There is a marked increase in psychological distress in 70% (as estimated through a recent survey) of the population, although how it translates into mental health disorders is yet to be seen,"

Dr Sen states in the report. "There is no school, no routine or structure, no healthy recreation, and no sense of safety or predictability..."

AMID SHUTDOWN and anger in the Valley, Girish Chandra Murmu and R K Mathur became the first Lieutenant Governors of the Union Territories of Jammu and Kashmir and Ladakh, respectively, as the state of J&K was officially bifurcated on Thursday.

The oath ceremony was a low-key affair with only top civil and security officials in attendance. While the media was kept at bay, most of the mainstream political leaders stayed away from the function at Raj Bhawan in Srinagar.

Sardar Patel's birth anniversary was chosen as the day to integrate Jammu and Kashmir with the Union of India as the country celebrates October 31 as the National Unity Day. While the government had earlier decided against celebrations, several events were held in Kashmir for the first time to commemorate the birth anniversary of Patel, who is seen as the force behind the integration of princely states with the Union of India. Police and civil administration installed 12x18-inch portraits of Patel across government offices, organised the Run for Unity and took pledges to uphold the unity and integrity of the country. **Justice Gita Mittal, the Chief**

Justice of the High Court for Jammu and Kashmir and Ladakh, administered the oath of office and secrecy to Lt Governors Mathur and Murmu at low-key events in Leh and then in Srinagar, respectively.

J&K's Chief Secretary B V R Subrahmanyam read the Warrant of Appointment at the function in Srinagar attended by former advisors, top civil and security officials and high court judges. While most mainstream political leaders and workers are under detention, those who are out gave the event a miss. The only exceptions were BIP leaders and PDP Rajya Sabha member Nazir Ahmad Laway, who attended the event.

IN THE first official comments to counter criticism over the controversial visit of Members of European Parliament to Jammu and Kashmir, the Ministry of External Affairs on Thursday said a clear distinction has to be made between "sharing India's perspective" and "internationalising the issue".

MEA spokesperson Raveesh Kumar said these MEPs had "expressed a keen desire" to see the situation on the ground, and their statements clearly reflected that they got an understanding of "how terrorism affects India. and how terrorism affects Kashmir". Kumar said it was sort of a

"familiarisation visit" for these MEPs, who were from different political parties and countries.

Responding to criticism that the visit was organised by private organisations, the MEA spokesperson said that there are

dignitaries which take place through non-official channels. "It is not necessary that such visits take place only through official channels," he said, pointing to the recent visit of former US Secretary of State Henry Kissinger, who was in India at the invitation of a think tank.

The visit of the European parliamentarians was not ceding of ground on Kashmir, he said, adding that it was important to see whether such an engagement serves larger national

He also countered the criticism that the visit by EU MPs to Kashmir was internationalisation of the issue, as he said that a clear distinction has to be made between "sharing India's perspective" and "internationalis-

ing the issue". A team of 23 MEPs travelled to Kashmir on Tuesday on a twoday trip for a first-hand assessment of the situation after the state's special status was re-

voked in August.

BAHALNAGAR (MURSHIDABAD), OCTOBER 31

OVER THE last few years, hundreds of men from villages in Sagardighi area of Murshidabad have been heading to Kashmir, attracted by far higher daily wages and a short work season of two months.

Mainul Haque (40), popularly called "Kashmirer lok" (the man from Kashmir) at Bahalnagar in Murshidabad district, was one of the first men from the village to go to the

Valley to work, according to his family and local residents.

His sister Ruksana Bewa (45) said, "It was 1998-99. Haque, then 20 years old, went to Delhi for a better job. We didn't have any news of him for 2-3 months. But he returned home with good money."

After returning home, Haque told his family and villagers about his experiences in Delhi, and his meeting with a Kashmiri who was searching for labourers and how they could earn good money there. In the hope of better prospects, other villagers joined Haque in his yearly trip to Kashmir every October.

In 4-5 years, Kashmir became a popular work destination for residents of Bahalnagar and neighbouring villages. In the last two decades, the number of people who flocked to Kashmir reached 400.

"This year, too, Haque went to Kashmir with other villagers in the first week of October. But he hasn't returned yet. On Tuesday he called me and said he was safe," said his wife Rakhina Bibi (30), sitting in her semi-concrete courtyard.

However, the number of villagers who went to Kashmir plummeted this year because of the lockdown and a series of militant attacks targeting nonresidents. Now, they said, they preferred to travel to Kerala. where labour is in short supply. Serina Bibi (60), a neigh-

bour of one of five labourers who were gunned down in Kashmir, said: "Where is the work here? Labourers have no jobs here, apart from some work in the paddy season."

Salema Bibi (35), Haque's neighbour, said, "In Kashmir, our men can earn plenty of money in a short time. In the apple and paddy harvest season, they can earn up to Rs 800 daily. In Bahalnagar, our daily wage is Rs 250."



Blackmailed and sexually abused by neighbour, girl killed mother, say police

EXPRESS NEWS SERVICE HYDERABAD, OCTOBER 31

A RELATIONSHIP that took an unexpected turn led to blackmail and murder, and finally the arrest of three people, all residents of the same locality here, police said.

The details came to light during the investigation into the murder of a woman, whose decomposed body was found on the railway tracks on the outskirts of Hyderabad on October 21. The woman's daughter and her boyfriend, both college students, and their neighbour have been arrested. The daughter and neighbour have been charged with murder, while the two men have been charged under POCSO Act.

Police officials said that the woman was strangled to death by her daughter under the instructions of and with help from the neighbour. "He was blackmailing and sexually exploiting

the girl," an official said.

"The girl was in a relationship with a boy from the same locality. Last September, the girl, who was then a minor, got pregnant. The boyfriend sought the neighbour's help... After the abortion, the neighbour began blackmailing her for sex... He forcibly took photos of her and demanded Rs 10 lakh... He threatened to reveal the photos to her boyfriend... When the neighbour heard that the mother owned land... he started pressuring the girl to kill her so that the land could be sold and he could get the money," the official said.

On October 19, the girl allegedly threw chilli powder into her mother's eyes. The neighbour knocked her down and the teen strangled her with a chunni. The neighbour then returned to his house while the girl went to her boyfriend's house.

"(The girl and her neighbour) tried to hang the body to make it look like suicide. But the body had

started decomposing, so they wrapped it in a blanket and on October 21, took it to Ramanapet and dumped it on railway tracks. The Government Railway Police found the body, and cremated it the next day as they could not identify it," an official said.

On October 24, her father, a truck driver, returned home and found it locked. When he called up his daughter, she said she was at Visakhapatnam, and feigned ignorance about the whereabouts of her mother.

While police started investigating, the boyfriend's father visited the girl's father and mentioned that she was at his house for three days. Suspecting something amiss, the girl's father called up the police and told them she had lied about her whereabouts. The police then took her into custody and interrogated her. It was then that she revealed the story, police said.

Former Prime Minister Manmohan Singh, Punjab Chief Minister Amarinder Singh and Union Minister Hardeep Puri are among the 575 people who will be part of the inaugural jatha to Gurdwara Darbar Sahib, Central government sources had said.

Kumar also said the Indian side has shared a list of 480 people for a visit to Nankana Sahib, the birthplace of Guru Nanak and sought visas for them.

Pak violated Vienna Convention in Jadhav case: ICI to UNGA

YOSHITA SINGH UNITED NATIONS, OCTOBER 31

PAKISTAN VIOLATED its obligations under the Vienna Convention in the arrest and detention of Indian national Kulbhushan Jadhav, International Court of Justice (ICJ) President Judge Abduylqawi Yusuf told the UN General Assembly here.

Jadhav, 49, a retired Indian Navy officer, was sentenced to death by a Pakistani military court on charges of "espionage and terrorism" after a closed trial in April 2017. India has maintained that Jadhav was kidnapped from Iran where he had business interests after retiring from the Navy.

Presenting the ICI's report to the 193-member General Assembly on Wednesday, Yusuf said in its judgment of July 17, the principal judicial organ of the UN "found that Pakistan had violated its obligations under Article 36 of the Vienna Convention and that appropriate remedies were due in this case."

In a major victory for India, the ICI had ruled that Pakistan must review the death sentence given to Jadhav. India had argued that consular access was being denied to its national in violation of the 1963 Vienna Convention on Consular Relations.

The bench led by Yusuf had ordered an "effective review and reconsideration of the conviction and sentence of Kulbhushan Sudhir Jadhav."
