Punctuation

Punctuation is very important in any language. Wrong punctuation can lead to wrong meaning. There are 16 punctuation marks in English grammar, and at minimum, one of



them has to appear in every sentence to make it easily understood.

Comma (,)

The comma is used to indicate a short pause. It is also used:

a) for words, phrases, and clauses in a series.

Eg. "Gandhiji, the Father of the Nation, died on 30th January, 1948."

"Apples, mangoes and bananas are my favourites."

b) When you address a person. Eg. "Yes, Sir."

c) To separate numbers, dates and address. Eg. I was born on 9th August, 1990.

d) When two persons, things or other elements are contrasted, the two are separated by a comma.

Eg. I meant Raj, not Robin.

e) Direct quotations are marked by comma. **Eg.** She said, "I'm sorry."

The Apostrophe (')

This item was given earlier. But reproduced briefly.

- It is used to indicate possessive [యొక్క] case i.e., to say something belongs to someone. E.g. Rajasekhar's bag
- In the case of plural nouns ending with 's' there is no need to add 's' after the apostrophe.
- e.g. boys' bags, girls' books
- In the case of other plural nouns NOT ending with "s" both the apostrophe and "s" are used.
- e.g. children's park, women's hostel
- In the case of proper nouns [సర్వనామాలు] ending with 's' both the apostrophe and 's' are used. **e.g.** Thomas's dairy; Biswas's brother; Srinivas's wife

The Apostrophe is also used to indicate missing letters in contracted [సంక్షిష్ణ] forms. e.g. He won't do it. (will not) We shan't do such things (shall not) Bread 'n butter is the sole reason for *learning English. (and)* I'm hungry. (I am) She's three. (She is/has) Don't use the Apostrophe with <u>'it'</u> in

possessive [యొక్క అనే అర్థం] cases. The dog licked its paw. The horse lifted its

But "it is" అనే అర్థంలో వాడినప్పుడు (') వాడాలి It's of no use going there. (It is) It's a metal rod in it. (It has)

Also don't use the Apostrophe with yours. Yours sincerely, Yours faithfully, Yours truly....

How to use Not only....but also?

Many people do this easily. But there are some confusion areas in this usage. When using not only... but also in a sentence, parallelism should be the goal. అంటే రెండు ಭಾಗಾಲ್ಲ್ ಒತೆ ಭಾಷಾ ಭಾಗಂ (Part of the Speech) ఉండాలి దీని అర్థం ఏమిటంటే, not only తర్వాత ఒక

verb వేస్తే but also తర్వాత కూడా verb రావాలి.

Eg. Ramana works in an office during the day. In the evening he drives a Uber cab. Ramana not only works in an office during the day but also drives a Uber cab in the evenings.

We have not used also with but. Instead, as well is used at the end. Thus, you can take some freedom, if you are confident about your usage.

PHRASAL VERBS contd...

We have been learning Phrasal Verbs with different Verbs in some issues. This issue deals with Phrasal Verbs that can be derived with the verb 'COUNT'.

- count down: to count backwards to zero, esp like in the launching of a space vehicle. It is also used in other senses. Eg. The count down for his fall has begun.
- count as: [గణనలోకి తీసుకోవడం] Eg. The city councils in Britain count their libraries as an important part of public service. E.g. Supply of cooking

fuel is counted as the duty of the government in India.

- count on / upon: [ఆధార పడటం], depend on Eg. In coalition governments, the ruling party counts on the support of their allies.
- count out: not to include. [මිජුණ්\$ తీసుకోకపోవడం]
 - Eg. Please count me out of the programme. I'm not interested.
- count up: to find the total of something. Eg. Count up all your gift boxes; make sure that we have one for each child in the ashram.
