

CBDT mops up ₹6L cr in direct tax collections so far this fiscal

NEW DELHI, NOVEMBER 14

THE GOVERNMENT has so far mopped up Rs 6 lakh crore, or less than 50 per cent of the total tax collection target of Rs 13.35 lakh crore, for the current fiscal year, said Central Board of Direct Taxes (CBDT) Chairman P C Mody.

Efforts are being made to achieve the target set in the Budget, Mody said after inauguration of the Taxpayers Lounge at Pragati Maidan here.

"During the beginning of the year, we were given the tax collection (target) of Rs 13.35 lakh crore. Of this, we have already collected Rs 6 lakh crore so far," he said.

Refunds due to the tax payers are done swiftly, he said, adding that the refunds have gone up 20 per cent compared to the last fiscal year.

"Efforts are made towards tax collection and I have full confidence that we will reach the target set in the Budget," Mody said.

He also said that the tax payer services is one of the focus area of CBDT. Keeping this in mind, a member has been appointed for tax payer services.

IN CONNECTION WITH PROBE AGAINST IL&FS
ED likely to attach assets of three borrowers of IFIN

THE ENFORCEMENT Directorate (ED) is likely to provisionally attach assets worth about Rs 1,600 crore belonging to three borrowers of IL&FS Financial Services (IFIN), in connection with its money laundering probe into the collapse of IL&FS, said sources.

Sources said that the agency is looking to attach a Rs 1,000-crore plant of ABG Shipyard in Gujarat, a few properties belonging to Nikhil Gandhi-promoted SKIL Infrastructure and Viren Ahuja-promoted Flemingo Geowork.

Emails sent to SKIL Infrastructure and Flemingo Geowork InfraProjects Pvt Ltd remained unanswered.

ABG is currently under liquidation under the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code (IBC).

The ED probe has found that third-party lending by IFIN to companies like ABG Shipyard and SKIL caused a loss of Rs 2,000 crore to IFIN, the non-banking financial arm of the IL&FS Group.

Earlier this year, a report by the Serious Fraud Investigation

Sources said that the Enforcement Directorate is looking to attach a Rs 1,000-crore plant of ABG Shipyard, a few properties belonging to SKIL Infrastructure and Flemingo Geowork

Office (SFIO) found several lapses in 13 loans of around Rs 1,080 crore granted by IFIN since 2010 to the ABC Group, promoted by Rishi Agarwal.

The probe agency has termed a few of these transactions as an "evergreening exercise", where the ABG Group used some money borrowed from IFIN to prevent its accounts from turning into non-performing assets (NPAs).

The SFIO report said that, in 2017, the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) in its report on IFIN for fiscal 2015 had red flagged insufficient security cover in terms of exposure to ABG International, and its group firm Onaway Industries.

However, it was only in

September 2018 that IFIN classified its loan to ABG Shipyard as an NPA.

The ED has alleged that in case of Flemingo Geowork, IFIN lent over Rs 500 crore to it for an infrastructure project, of which about Rs 9 crore was allegedly routed to Ahuja's personal bank account.

The ED has alleged that more than Rs 5,000 crore of shareholders' money has been laundered by IFIN. The agency has, so far, provisionally attached assets worth Rs 150 crore of IFIN's top five in the board of directors.

The IL&FS Group has total liabilities of Rs 91,000 crore. The SFIO has found several irregularities across corporate governance and financial parameters that led to a default crisis at IL&FS.

The alleged financial irregularities at IL&FS came to light in September 2018, after some group entities started defaulting on debt repayments.

The entire group has been defaulting on repayments since then. The government subsequently superseded the company's board and appointed a new management to work on a resolution plan.

Union Bank posts ₹1,194 cr Q2 loss

STATE-OWNED UNION Bank of India on Thursday reported a net loss of Rs 1,194 crore for the July-September quarter as against a net profit of Rs 139 crore in the same quarter of 2018-19 as provisioning increased during the quarter.

Total income for the September quarter rose to Rs 10,556.57 crore from Rs 9,438.26 crore in the same period a year ago, the bank said in a regulatory filing.

Its provisioning for bad loans

jumped to Rs 3,328.30 crore for the quarter from Rs 1,710 crore parked aside for the same a year ago. Overall provisioning was Rs 3,858.75 crore as against Rs 1,715.55 crore.

The asset quality of the bank continued to remain in the bad territory as the gross non-performing assets (NPAs) stood at 15.24 per cent (Rs 49,850 crore) of the gross loans at the end of September 2019, as compared to 15.74 per cent a year ago. Recovery and upgradation during July-September 2019 increased by 69.2 per cent to Rs 1,303 crore as against Rs 770 crore in the June quarter. Net NPA ratio

stood at 6.98 per cent as of September 2019 as against 7.23 per cent in June 2019 and 8.42 per cent in the same period as last year. Provision coverage ratio improved to 67.75 per cent as on September 30, 2019 as against 65.88 per cent as on June 30, 2019.

Domestic advances increased by 2.5 per cent to Rs 309,449 crore as of September 2019 from Rs 302,007 crore a year ago. Retail advances grew by 15.7 per cent to Rs 59,335 crore from Rs 51,270 crore a year ago. Net interest income for July-September 2019 increased by 16.5 per cent to Rs 2,906 crore from Rs 2,494 crore for July-September 2018.

India Pavilion at Expo 2020 event in Dubai to have 'future' as theme

WITH 192 participating countries, more than 50 international cuisines, 60 live events and an expected 25 million visitors — the upcoming Expo 2020 in Dubai is turning out to be among the biggest international events held in this part of the world. The 192-country participation surpasses the 180-nation commitment made in Dubai's 2013 host bid, say its organisers.

"Expo 2020 will move away from traditional geographical clusters and band together countries facing similar challenges within the three subthemes: opportunity, mobility and sustainability," said Sanjive Khosla, chief commercial officer, Expo 2020, who was in Delhi on Tuesday.

Every participating country will have its own pavilion for the first time in the 168-year history of World Expos. While many have already revealed the design and theme, others are giving final touches to their concept, ahead of the six-month-long event, which kicks off on October 20, 2020. For instance, the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia Pavilion will showcase the Kingdom's rich heritage and openness to businesses and tourists, while the UK Pavilion is inspired by a project from the late scientist Stephen Hawking. The India Pavilion — being supervised by FICCI — will be based on the theme of future, adds Khosla.

Expo 2020 will also be an F&B destination in its own right, with more than 200 outlets serving more than 50 kinds of global cuisines. There will be more than 60 live events each day for 173 days, featuring prominent international artists. Named after the Arabic word for 'connection', Al Wasl Plaza will be the centrepiece of Expo 2020, hosting major ceremonies and celebrations during and after Expo. "After April 2021, the 4.38 sq km site will be transformed into District 2020, a world-class integrated community that will reuse at least 80 per cent of Expo's built environment," explained Khosla.

In April 2019, Ernst & Young published an independent report that stated that Expo 2020 Dubai and its legacy are expected to contribute AED 122.6 billion to the UAE's economy from 2013-31. A lot of this financial fillip will come in through tourism, as Dubai expects to welcome 25 million visitors between October 2020 and April 2021. Speaking on the tourism aspect, Issam Kazim, chief operating officer, Dubai Tourism, said, "Dubai has immense possibilities for visitors before, during and after

the Expo... When we started off many years ago with the Dubai Shopping Festival, it set the scene for Dubai to attract visitors for a specific event."

At any given time, someone comes to Dubai, there is always some celebration, he added. For instance, we celebrate Diwali in a big way, and as soon as it's over, there's the UAE National Day celebrations, followed by Chinese New Year, he remarked. He spoke about new attractions for repeat visitors in Dubai, including the adventure activities in the Hatta area, the new offerings for art and culture aficionados in the old part of the city, and new restaurants. "Besides, there's always the retail calendar which pulls a lot of visitors from India," said Kazim.

The World Expo is one of the world's oldest and largest international events, taking place every five years and lasting six months. The first World Expo was London's Great Exhibition of 1851. The Expo 2020 theme, 'Connecting Minds, Creating the Future', is based on the belief that innovation and progress are the result of people and ideas coming together.

Ford to use Mustang name for e-SUV

Ford Motor Co will use the Mustang name, previously reserved for a muscle car, for an electric sport utility vehicle (SUV) that customers in the United States, Canada and Europe can start ordering on Nov. 17, the company said on Thursday.

Ford confirmed its new electric SUV will be called the Mustang Mach-E ahead of a debut event scheduled for Los Angeles on Sunday. Until now, the Mustang name has been used only on a line of sporty coupes associated with Detroit's 1960s muscle car era.

The SUV will be among a more than dozen all-electric automobiles the company plans to launch by 2022 with an investment of \$11.5 billion as it moves away from traditional gas-powered cars. In April, the No.2 US carmaker invested \$500 million in Rivian and said it planned to use the Michigan startup's platform to build a new Ford-branded electric vehicle.

Boeing drops system used to build 777 jets

Bengaluru: Boeing has abandoned a key automation system used to make fuselage sections for its 777 jetliners amid reports of reliability issues, and will instead partially switch back to mechanics, it said Thursday.

The company began to build 777 fuselages in 2015 in an upright orientation, with robots drilling holes and installing fasteners, an initiative known as fuselage automated upright build (FAUB).

The world's biggest plane-maker said it had stopped using the system which, according to industry sources, caused problems with reliability and rework issues. **REUTERS**
