CBDT mops up ₹6L cr in direct tax collections so far this fiscal

THE GOVERNMENT has so far mopped up Rs 6 lakh crore, or less than 50 per cent of the total tax collection target of Rs 13.35 lakh crore, for the current fiscal year, said Central Board of Direct Taxes (CBDT) Chairman P C Mody.

Efforts are being made to achieve the target set in the Budget, Mody said after inauguration of the Taxpayers Lounge at Pragati Maidan here. "During the beginning of

the year, we were given the tax collection (target) of Rs 13.35 lakh crore. Of this, we have already collected Rs 6 lakh crore so far," he said.

Refunds due to the tax payers are done swiftly, he said, adding that the refunds have gone up 20 per cent compared to the last fiscal year.

"Efforts are made towards tax collection and I have full confidence that we will reach the target set in the Budget," Mody said.

ED likely to attach assets of three borrowers of IFIN

KHUSHBOO NARAYAN MUMBAI, NOVEMBER 14

THE ENFORCEMENT Directorate (ED) is likely to provisionally attach assets worth about Rs1,600 crore belonging to three borrowers of IL&FS Financial Services (IFIN), in connection with its money laundering probe into the collapse of IL&FS, said sources.

Sources said that the agency is looking to attach a Rs 1,000crore plant of ABG Shipyard in Gujarat, a few properties belonging to Nikhil Gandhi-promoted SKIL Infrastructure and Viren Ahuja-promoted Flemingo Geowork.

Emails sent to SKIL Infrastructure and Flemingo Geowork Infraprojects Pvt Ltd remained unanswered.

ABG is currently under liquidation under the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code (IBC).

The ED probe has found that third-party lending by IFIN to companies like ABG Shipyard and SKIL caused a loss of Rs 2,000 crore to IFIN, the nonbanking financial arm of the IL&FS Group.

The probe agency has termed a few of these transactions as an "evergreening exercise", where the ABG Group used some money borrowed from IFIN to prevent its accounts from turning into non-performing assets (NPAs).

The SFIO report said that, in 2017, the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) in its report on IFIN for fiscal 2015 had red flagged insufficient security cover in terms of exposure to ABG International, and its group firm Onaway

However, it was only in

September 2018 that IFIN classified its loan to ABG Shipyard as an NPA.

The ED has alleged that in case of Flemingo Geowork, IFIN lent over Rs 500 crore to it for an infrastructure project, of which about Rs 9 crore was allegedly routed to Ahuja's personal bank account.

The ED has alleged that more than Rs 5,000 crore of shareholders' money has been laundered by IFIN. The agency has, so far, provisionally attached assets worth Rs 150 crore of IFIN's top five in the board of directors.

The IL&FS Group has total liabilities of Rs 91,000 crore. The SFIO has found several irregularities across corporate governance and financial parameters that led to a default crisis at

The alleged financial irregularities at IL&FS came to light in September 2018, after some group entities started defaulting on debt repayments.

The entire group has been defaulting on repayments since then. The government subsequently superseded the company's board and appointed a new management to work on a resolution plan.

Promoters' feud has 'zero impact' on IndiGo, says CEO

New Delhi: Amid an ongoing feud between IndiGo's promoters, CEO Ronojoy Dutta on Thursday said there is "zero impact" on the carrier right now as they are on the same page over the airline's strategic direction.

The differences between the co-founders and co-promoters — Rakesh Gangwal and Rahul Bhatia came to the fore in July after Gangwal sought market regulator Sebi's intervention to address alleged corporate governance

lapses at the company.

They are the promoters of InterGlobe Aviation, which operates IndiGo, the country's largest airline in terms of domestic market share. About the feud. Dutta said as far as the airline is concerned, it was only directly involved in the Related Party Transactions (RPTs).

"That has been resolved completely ... Now that RPTs have been removed from the table, we have no more interest in this matter." he told *PTI* in an interview. **PTI**

Wholesale inflation at 0.16% in Oct

WHOLESALE INFLATION slipped to about a three-and-a-half-year low of 0.16 per cent in October on account of a decline in prices of manufactured goods though food products remained dearer, the government data showed on Thursday.

The previous low was in June 2016 when the Wholesale Price Index (WPI)-based inflation was a negative 0.1 per cent. In September this year, the

WPI-based inflation was at 0.33 per cent, while it stood at 5.54 per cent in October 2018. The rate of price rise for food

articles was 9.80 per cent during the month, while for non-food articles it stood at 2.35 per cent, showed the data released by the commerce and industry ministry. The wholesale inflation in po-

tato remained in the negative zone at 19.60 per cent (from -22.50 per cent in September). However, for vegetables, the inflation jumped to 38.91 per

cent in October from 19.43 per cent a month ago, while that for pulses, it remained elevated at 16.57 per cent as compared with 17.94 per cent.

Net interest income for July-September 2019 increased by 16.5 per cent to Rs 2,906 crore from Rs 2,494 crore for July-September 2018.

Discussions on to find solution for Manesar plant, says HMSI

THE MANAGEMENT at Honda Motorcycle and Scooter India (HMSI) is looking for a resolution to their standoff with the trade union, the firm's senior vice-president sales and marketing, Yadvinder Singh Guleria said on Thursday.

Around 2,500 contract workers at the company's Manesar plant have been on an indefinite strike to protest against retrenchment of over 200 such workers last week, when, on Monday, all "normal operations" in the plant were suspended without citing a date for its resumption.

"Discussions are going on (for a resolution to the issue) ... their (contractual workers') tenure was over, so they were not employed further," Guleria told reporters.

On Wednesday, a few hundred workers sat in protest outside the plant, while around 1,500-1,800 — the workers' claimed — protested inside the plant premises. Most, they said, have been working at the plant on contract basis for at least eight years. The protests continued on Thursday, with the workers demanding their dues be paid. "We

have given the most important years of our lives to the company." Prior to the laying off this

month, 700 contractual workers had been let go in August. "We had been earning Rs 14,000 per month since 2014

without any revision. Now they've told us that they'll call us back 'when they require our services'. They regularise 50 most senior contract workers every year, but they haven't done that in the last two years. Nobody got the Diwali bonus this year. They must regularise all contract workers now; we won't move from here until they do," said Manas Ranjan Tripathi, who had worked at the plant on a contract basis for a decade.

Protesting workers are receiving support from the 1,900 regular workers at the plant.

HMSI has cited low production and low demand for twowheelers as the reason for the lavoffs. However, the protesting workers say they do not buy that argument. In an earlier statement. an HMSI spokesperson said, "Based on demand fluctuations and production adjustment, 200 contractual members whose term had been completed are relieved from their work."

Every participating country will have its own pavilion for the first time in the 168-year history of World Expos. While many have already revealed the design and theme, others are giving final touches to their concept, ahead of the six-month-long event, which kicks off on October 20, 2020. For instance, the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia Pavilion will showcase the Kingdom's rich heritage and openness to businesses and tourists, while the UK Pavilion is inspired by a project from the late scientist Stephen Hawking. The India Pavilion — being supervised by FICCI — will be based on the theme of future, adds Khosla.

Expo 2020 will also be an F&B destination in its own right, with more than 200 outlets serving more than 50 kinds of global cuisines. There will be more than 60 live events each day for 173 days, featuring prominent international artistes. Named after the Arabic word for 'connection', Al Wasl Plaza will be the centrepiece of Expo 2020, hosting major ceremonies and celebrations during and after Expo. "After April 2021, the 4.38 sq km site will be transformed into District 2020, a world-class integrated community that will reuse at least 80 per cent of Expo's built environment," explained Khosla.

In April 2019, Ernst & Young published an independent report that stated that Expo 2020 Dubai and its legacy are expected to contribute AED122.6 billion to the UAE's economy from 2013–31. A lot of this financial fillip will come in through tourism, as Dubai expects to welcome 25 million visits between October 2020 and April 2021. Speaking on the tourism aspect, Issam Kazim, chief operating officer, Dubai Tourism, said, "Dubai has immense possibilities for visitors before, during and after

the Expo ... When we started off many years ago with the Dubai Shopping Festival, it set the scene for Dubai to attract visitors for a specific event."

At any given time, someone comes to Dubai, there is always some celebration, he added. For instance, we celebrate Diwali in a big way, and as soon as it's over there's the UAE National Day celebrations, followed by Chinese New year, he remarked. He spoke about new attractions for repeat visitors in Dubai, including the adventure activities in the Hatta area the new offerings for art and culture aficionados in the old part of the city, and new restaurants. "Besides, there's always the retail calendar which pulls a lot of visi-

tors from India," said Kazim. The World Expo is one of the world's oldest and largest international events, taking place every five years and lasting six months. The first World Expo was London's Great Exhibition of 1851. The Expo 2020 theme, 'Connecting Minds, Creating the Future', is based on the belief that innovation and progress are the result of people and ideas coming together.

Ford to use Mustang name for e-SUV

Ford Motor Co will use the Mustang name, previously reserved for a muscle car, for an electric sport utility vehicle (SUV) that customers in the United States, Canada and Europe can start ordering on Nov. 17, the company said on Thursday.

Ford confirmed its new electric SUV will be called the Mustang Mach-E ahead of a debut event scheduled for Los Angeles on Sunday. Until now, the Mustang name has been used only on a line of sporty coupes associated with Detroit's 1960s muscle car era.

The SUV will be among a more than dozen all-electric automobiles the company plans to launch by 2022 with an investment of \$11.5 billion as it moves away from traditional gas-powered cars. In April, the No.2 US carmaker invested \$500 million in Rivian and said it planned to use the Michigan startup's platform to build a new Ford-branded electric vehicle.

Boeing drops system used to build 777 jets Bengaluru: Boeing has aban-

doned a key automation system used to make fuselage sections for its 777 jetliners amid reports of reliability issues, and will instead partially switch back to mechanics, it said Thursday.

The company began to build 777 fuselages in 2015 in an upright orientation, with robots drilling holes and installing fasteners, an initiative known as fuselage automated upright build (FAUB). The world's biggest plane-

maker said it had stopped using the system which, according to industry sources, caused problems with reliability and rework issues. **REUTERS**
