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## MODEL QUESTIONS

**Directions (Q.No.1-5):** Study the following information carefully and answer the questions given below:

Seven persons A, B, C, D, T, U and V who have a white money in various Banks. Each of them has a different amount of white money among Rs19887,8697, 6734, 4537, 2436, 3624 and 28116, but not necessarily in the same order. Each person kept his/her white money in one of the branches among SBI, ICICI and HDFC. At least two persons kept their white money in each branch. C's white money is not kept in SBI branch. D's white money is not Rs.3624. B's white money is the third highest. Only those persons-whose white money is the least and the second least kept their white money in SBI. B's white money is more than T's white money and they kept their white money in the same branch. No other person kept his/her money in this branch. Neither C's nor U's white money is the highest. Either U's or A's white money is Rs.19887 and both of them kept their white money in ICICI branch.

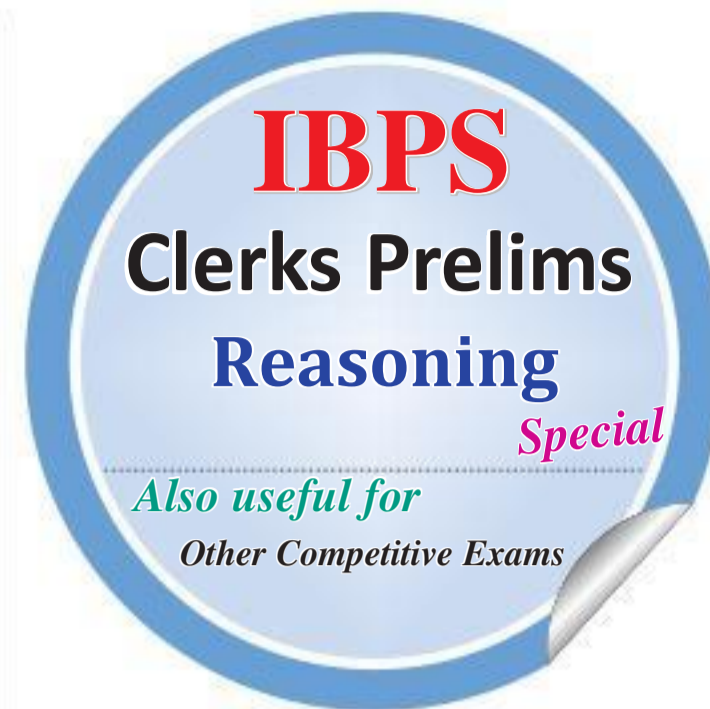

Rama is sister-in-law of Vamsi and standing 9m to the north of her mother.

Aarna, Advika, Akshara, Angle, Anvi, Avni, Anika and Amala are sitting around a circular area at equal distance between each other, but not necessarily in the same order. Some of the persons are facing the center while some others are facing outside (i.e. in a direction opposite the center.) **Note:** Same direction means that if one person is facing the center

then the other person is also facing the center and vice versa. Opposite direction means that if one person is facing the center then the other person is facing outside and vice versa. Anvi sits second to the right of Anika. Anika faces the center. Advika sits third to the left of Anvi. Anvi and Advika face opposite directions. Immediate neighbors of Advika face the center. Akshara sits second to the right of Advika. Amala sits on the immediate left of Akshara. Aarna sits second to the left of Angle. Angle faces the same direction as Advika. Angle is not an immediate neighbor of Anika. Immediate neighbors of Anvi face opposite directions (i.e. if one neighbor faces the center the other neighbor faces outside and vice versa).

Rajesh is second to the right of Mahesh and both of them are males. Harini is a female and not a neighbour of Mahesh. Siri and the two immediate neighbours of Siri are of opposite genders. Uma and the one to her immediate left are females. Uma is a neighbour of Kavitha but not Ravi. Sasi is not in the same line of sight as Kavitha or Ravi. Ravi and Siva are of same gender.

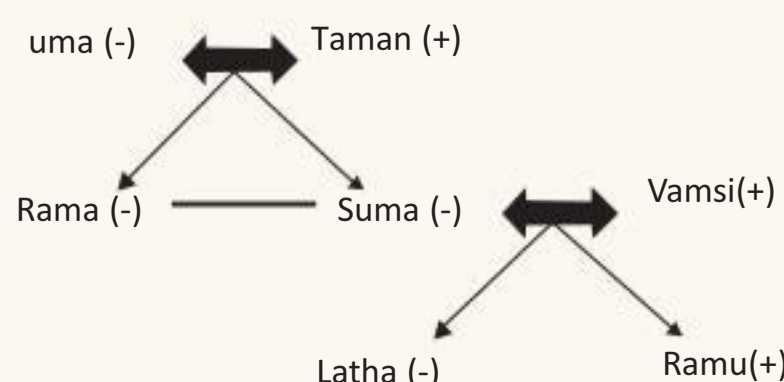

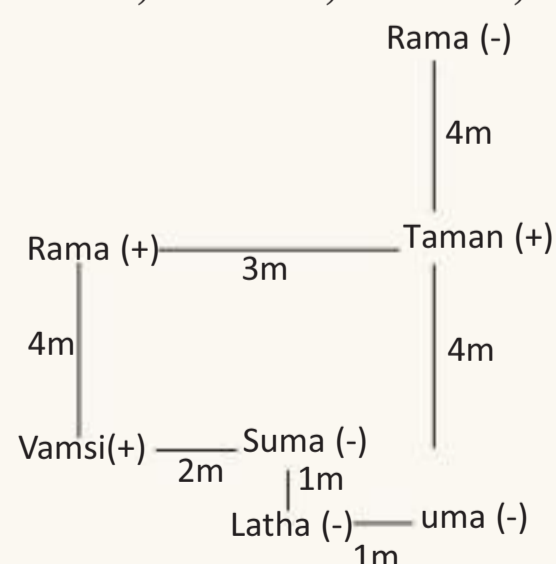

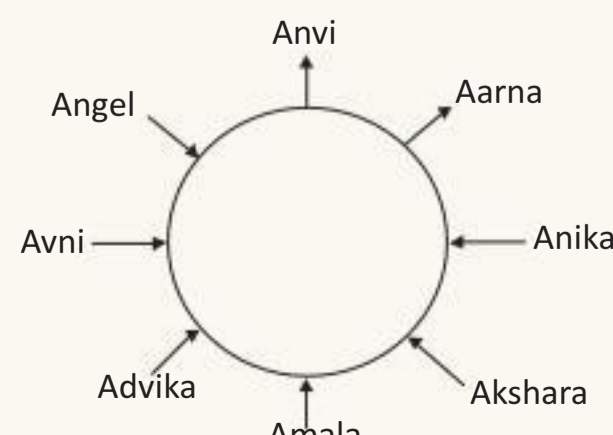
