The Enforcement Directorate has concluded arguments on a plea for confiscation of ₹14,000 crore assets linked to businessman Vijay Mallya, who was declared a runaway under the Fugitive Economic Offenders Act (FCOA) in January. Proceedings on the question of confiscation are under way before a Mumbai court.

Arun Shourie suffers brain injury, hospitalised

Former Union Minister Arun Shourie sustained a brain injury after he fainted and fell near his home in Lavasa and was admitted to a private hospital here in Maharashtra, a doctor said on Monday. Mr. Shourie, 78, fell near his bungalow in Lavasa while out on a walk on Sunday night, leaving him bleeding and unconscious, he said. PTI

SC declines plea against polygamy

‘Will consider listing the case after the winter vacation’

The Supreme Court on Monday did not accede to a request to urgently list a petition seeking a declaration that the practice of polygamy and *nikah halala* are unconstitutional. A Bench led by Chief Justice of India Sharad A. Bobde told petitioner-advocate Ashwini Upadhyay that the court would consider listing the case after the winter vacation. The petition wants the court to declare Section 2 of



the Muslim Personal Law (Shariat) Application Act, 1937, unconstitutional and in violation of Articles 14, 15 and 21 of the Constitution, insofar as it seeks to recognise and validate the practice of polygamy and *nikah halala*. Mr. Upadhyay has contended that a “ban on polygamy and *nikah halala* has been the need of the hour to secure basic rights and in the interests of public order, morality and health.” “Injury caused to women through practice of triple talaq, polygamy and *nikah halala* is violative of Articles 14, 15 and 21 and injurious to public order, morality and health,” the petition said.

SC notice to Centre, IMA on doctors’ strike

Stir in June was against 2014 order: NGO

The Supreme Court on Monday asked the Union government and the Indian Medical Association (IMA) to respond to a contempt petition filed by NGO People for Better Treatment blaming them of turning a blind eye to a nationwide strike called by doctors despite a 2014 court prohibition. A Bench led by Chief Justice of India Sharad A. Bobde issued the notice on the petition filed by the

NGO. The plea said neither the government nor the IMA tried to prevent the doctors’ strike on June 17, 2019 that left patients in dire straits. The strike was held to demonstrate solidarity with the striking doctors of West Bengal following the assault on two junior doctors at NRS Hospital in Kolkata. The petition said the strike was held despite the November 11, 2014 court order, which “held that doctors should not resort to strike under any condition”.

NHRC seeks report on assault cases

Panel concerned over recent incidents of rape

Expressing concern over the recent sexual assault cases, the National Human Rights Commission on Monday issued notices to the Centre, States and Union Territories seeking reports on the standard operating procedure (SOP) for dealing with such cases and the use of the Nirbhaya Fund. The NHRC has asked the governments to respond in six weeks. Taking suo motu cognisance of media reports, the NHRC observed that there was a “dire need for all stakeholders to work jointly to get rid of this evil.” The Commission’s action comes in the wake of the gang-rape and murder of a doctor in Hyderabad that has spurred a debate on the condition of women’s security in the country once again.

‘Unsafe environment’ Issuing the notices, the Commission said the “largest democracy of the world, which has adopted the longest written Constitution and has a rich cultural heritage of gender equality, is today being criticised for having the most unsafe environment for women.” The NHRC said these cases were violations of the victims’ human rights. “There have been constitutional and statutory provisions to ensure that women are not subjected to any kind of discrimination and harassment. But, there is an alarming trend indicating that things are getting worse, amounting to violation of right to life, liberty, dignity and equality of women across the country,” it said.

Gujarat seeks speedy trials in rape cases

Following a spate of rape incidents in the State, the Gujarat government said on Monday that the police had nabbed some of the accused and the cases would be tried in special courts, expeditiously. The prosecution would ask for capital punishment for the accused, officials said. Three cases of rape have been registered in Rajkot, Surat and Vadodra. The accused in the Rajkot and Surat cases have been arrested. Gujarat’s Junior Home Minister Pradipsinh Jadeja said the government would request the High Court to shift these cases to fast-track courts for speedy trial.

1 arrested for rape, murder in Rajasthan

The Rajasthan police on Monday arrested a 40-year-old man on charges of rape and murder of a minor girl at Kherli village in Tonk district. The child’s body was recovered near the village on Sunday. The six-year-old girl was reported missing when she did not return from school. The condition of her body suggested that she was raped and strangled to death with her school belt. Superintendent of police Adarsh Sidhu said the accused Mahendra Meena, a truck driver, took the victim from her school to an isolated area and committed the crime. “Mahendra killed the girl because he feared that she would reveal his identity,” Mr. Sidhu said. The accused was in an inebriated state when he committed the crime. He was caught near Uniara and brought to Aligarh police station, where he admitted to having raped and killed the minor.
