Directions (Q.No.1-5): Study the following information to answer the given questions.

Representatives from eight different country's viz Aditya, Vihaan, Arjun, Muhammad, Sai, Krish, Aryan and Shaurya are sitting around a circular table facing the centre but not necessarily in the same order. Each one of them is from a different country viz. Russia, United States, Japan, Italy, Canada, France, Germany and United Kingdom.

Krish sits second to right of the representative from Italy. Representative from Germany is an immediate neighbour of the representative from Italy. Two people sit between the representative of Germany and Vihaan. Arjun and Sai are immediate neighbour of each other. Neither Arjun nor Sai is an immediate neighbour of either Vihaan or the representative from Italy. Representative from Japan sits second to right of Muhammad. Muhammad is neither the representative of Italy nor Germany. Aryan and the representative from Russia are immediate neighbours of each other. Vihaan is not the representative of Russia. Only one person sits between Arjun and the representative from United States. Shaurya sits third to left of the representative from United Kingdom. Representative from France sits second to left of the representative from Canada.
