A DAY after he threatened to resign, Shiv Sena MLA and Minister of State Abdul Sattar met Maharashtra Chief Minister Uddhav Thackeray on Sunday and said he is satisfied and that there is no question of him being unhappy.

After meeting Thackeray, Sattar told mediapersons that he had not resigned. "I have given (the CM) information about those who created rumours about me being unhappy. After meeting Uddhav ji, I am now satisfied and there is no question of unhappiness," he said when asked whether he was unhappy at not being made a Cabinet minister. In the portfolios allotted on Sunday, Sattar was chosen as MoS for Revenue and Rural Development.

Reports that Sattar was disgruntled over being allocated a MoS berth emerged after his supporters — six zilla parishad members – extended support to Sena rebel and BJP-backed Devyani Dongaokar for the president's post and BJP's L G Gaikwad for the deputy president's post in the Aurangabad Zilla Parishad, elections to which were held on Saturday. The Sena was contesting the elections under the banner of Maha Vikas Aghadi, the ruling alliance which includes the Congress and the NCP.

TWO SUSPECTED ISIS terrorists have entered Uttar Pradesh, following which a high alert has been sounded along the India-Nepal border in Maharajganj, Kushinagar and Siddharth Nagar districts, a top police official said on Sunday.

"It has come to the fore that two wanted terrorists - Abdul Samad and Iliyas — can escape to Nepal from UP," IG (Basti Range) Ashutosh Kumar said. The alert was sounded after the intelligence input was received, he said.

The IG said photographs of the two have been widely circulated so that they could be identified. The officer said he was not aware which outfit they were af-

filiated to. Previously, they were spotted in West Bengals' Siliguri and are suspected to be associated with the ISIS.

THE BODY of a 20-year-old Dalit woman, who reportedly went missing on January 1, was found hanging from a tree in a village of Modasa taluka in Aravalli district on Sunday.

Modasa Rural police have filed a case of accidental death and probe is underway.

A family member of the deceased said that the girl, a graduate, operated a beauty parlour. "She left home on January 1. After she didn't return home the next day, her father had given a complaint to Modasa Town police and had named a suspect for the mys-

daughter. However, (Modasa Town) the police did not register an offence and told the father that the case falls under the jurisdiction of Modasa Rural police. On Sunday morning, the woman's body was found hanging from a tree in the neighbouring village," said the family member. The person also alleged that

the Modasa Town police did not register the case as the suspect and the police inspector are from the same community.

Aravalli SP Mayur Patil said said that police did not take any coercive action against the person named as suspect by the woman's father because there was not enough evidence to do so.

The research work of professor Ajayan Vinu, global innovation chair and director at the University of Newcastle, on nano materials has led to the development of technologies for conversion of carbon dioxide into fuel

using sunlight and water and clean tech like sodium ion batteries to power electric vehicles.

Impressed by the research work of the Indian-origin nano materials scientist, the Indian Defence Ministry has awarded a \$2 million research project to Vinu to develop carbon nitride nano materials for clean energy system requirement in the defence sector.

This is probably the first time an Indian defence research requirement has been awarded to an Indian researcher based outside India, Vinu (43) said Sunday on the sidelines of the 107th Indian Science Congress, where he was one of the key speakers.

"It is a \$2 million project with Indian defence authorities. It is on the selective capture of carbon dioxide with nano porous carbon-based systems. They have seen our work on the carbon capture and grown interested in it. They were using some material that was not that effective and wanted to replace their existing adsorbent material in all their devices with our unique

material," Vinu said. The carbon nitride nano materials discovered since 2005 by Vinu — who is also associated with IIT Bombay, Institute of Chemical Technology Mumbai

and IISc Bangalore — has resulted

in production of sodium ion batteries for vehicles at his lab at the University of Newcastle and the prospect of development of an 'ultimate clean energy vehicle' a reality in three to four years, the professor said.

A senior defence research official from India is scheduled to visit the lab soon to look at technologies like the sodium ion batteries for possible adoption in India, he said.

"The materials I have discov-

ered — carbon nitrides like C3N5, C3N6, C3N7— have seen researchers from top institutions jumping into the field since these materials have unique semi conducting characteristics," Vinu said. The 'highly ordered carbon nitrides' discovered in his research is the only nano material that can be applied to all systems in a clean energy vehicle, according to the

scientist.
