# Divyansh juggling books and Olympic preparation

After dominating the European circuit, preparing for the season, by winning six gold medals from seven competitions, Divyansh Singh Panwar is busy juggling books and preparation for the Tokyo Olympics.

Coach Deepak Dubey who has been guiding Divyansh, a 12th standard student, for the last five years had accompanied the boy on the European circuit and was quite pleased with the work done and results accomplished.

#### Very keen

"The board exams are coming up. But, Divyansh has to shoot at the Delhi World Cup in March. He did not make the final last time, so he is keen. Moreover, all the Olympic quota winners

from around the world will be competing.

"It will be good for him to take part and learn more about nurturing the right temperament. Equally, it is important in the perspective of selection of the Indian team for the Olympics," said Deepak.

Divyansh will be appearing for two papers for the Board exam, and a request to the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) has already been routed through the National Federation and the Sports Authority of India (SAI) to help him have his other exams at a later date, when he does not have any international competition.

#### Ground work done

Even as Divyansh is going through the High Performance training camp at the Inspire Institute of Sport (IIS) of the Jindal Sports Foundation (JSF) in Vijaya-

nagar, Deepak observed that the ground work for the season had been done well.

"Divyansh shot three high scores 633.9, 632.2 and 632.4 in three different competitions in Austria, Germany and the Netherlands.

"It was important to compete with the European shooters, to become more tough mentally and to get

more information about the technical aspects of the rifle.

"It was a great experience to train at the oldest range in the world in Munich. It was good to work out in different climates and time zones," recalled Deepak.

Once he finishes training in Vijayanagar on February 16, Divyansh will be spending more time with the books.

The technical aspect of preparation for the Tokyo Olympics in July has already been addressed.

"After the H&N Cup in Munich, in which Divyansh won gold, the Walther company has assured all support for the rifle," said Deepak.

Deepak is impressed with the clarity of approach of Divyansh. "He is very clear about his goal.

"He is hard working, especially when he is on the firing lane. He is very sharp and focused," said Deepak.

## AIFF launches Football Management Program

It is a specific football masters course, says Kushal Das

The All India Football Federation (AIFF) on Thursday launched its Football Management Program (FMP) by signing an MOU with Spanish La Liga SmartBank co-leader Cadiz CF.

The IFMP will enable students to study in three cities over the course of a year - New Delhi, Mumbai and Cadiz (Spain).

According to AIFF general secretary Kushal Das, "such a program was needed keeping in mind the significant growth of football.

"It is a highly governed sport and requires the stakeholders to have a thorough knowledge of how to administer. It is a specific football masters course. The emphasis is clearly on professionalism in football."

"The program," insisted Das, "will be the first to be conducted by any sports federation in India. It will give a structured insight into governance of world foot-

ball as laid down in FIFA and AFC statutes and an understanding of the plethora of rules and regulations for managing football in India in line with best practices across the world."

"The AIFF Masters," Das added, "will provide students complete hands-on experiential training on every aspect of football in India and abroad through live tournament exposure, match staging, clubs and team management, data management and analysis, leadership and project management skills, con-

tractual and legal obligations, sponsorship marketing and business communication."

The AIFF will conduct a Common Admission Test to ensure that every interested candidate gets an equal opportunity to enroll in the limited seats on offer each year.

It will also have a strong line-up of global football faculty to share their knowledge and experience.

AIFF president Praful Patel observed: "Football is without any doubt the number one global sport and is

growing very quickly in India. We felt that such a Program was much needed to help students understand the nuances and global practices involved in managing football not only in India but across the world.

"With the curriculum combining theoretical and practical knowledge, there will be a paradigm shift in football management in the country."

The fee for the one-day course will be ₹2 lakh with Das promising "very good placements."
