### **9 ADMITTED FOR VIRUS TESTS IN CITY** BALU PULIPAKA I DC HYDERABAD, FEB. 5

Nine more people have been admitted to Gandhi and Fever hospitals in the city on Wednesday for check-ups and tests for possible coronavirus infections. While five of them were admitted to Gandhi, four others were admitted to the Fever Hospital. All these individuals were returning from China. Their blood and cheek

swab samples will be tested at the virology lab in Gandhi Hospital, and the results are expected by Thursday morning.

There was some confusion with rumours float-ing during the day that one person, who had came for getting checked for the disease, had run away from the Gandhi Hospital but in the end it turned out to be just that,

a rumour. According to an official, three passengers who had disembarked at the airport on Tuesday night, were flagged by medical staff because they exhibited some cold

and flu like symptoms. The three passengers were directed to go to the Gandhi Hospital directly from the airport.

Excluding the nine who were admitted to the two hospitals since Tuesday night, tests conducted on 25 persons so far — all of whom arrived after January 15 — tested negative for the disease. Tests on 26 others who arrived in the city between December 30 and January 15 were also

negative for the disease.

Over the last one month, the Board has been issuing more than 300 certificates per day, which is twice the number of applications that it receives on a normal day.

Around 50,000 Muslim weddings are solemnised a year in the state. The board has already issued nearly 40,000 marriage certificates in 2019.

According to officials of the Board, people are applying for the certifi-cates of the marriages which were solemnised 30-40 years ago. Officials also observed some people are applying for the marriage certificates of their parents.

If this trend continues, they claim the Board would have to issue one lakh certificates this year which will be an all time record.

and heart diseases. Such people face significant risk for sleep disorders and metabolic syndrome, both which contribute to poor heart health, as well as for Type-2 diabetes.

CDCP researchers found that there was a 27 per cent more likelihood of people developing heart disease after working a mere three night shifts a month compared to those who do not. According to a study by the National Centre for **Biotechnology Information** on the working conditions of nurses and impact on their health, women work-ing night shifts for longer periods of time were found to be at the higher end of risk spectrum. For example, women working night shifts for 10 or more years were found to have 13 to 27 per cent greater risk for heart disease than those

with no night shifts, while women with less than five years of night shift experience had up to 10 per cent increased risk. Dr Vikram Sharma, car-diologist, said, "during normal sleep, blood pres-sure goes down. Having

# **SCR sends SOS on TS projects** Anti-CAA protest Seeks state's cooperation to finish Cherlapally terminal, MMTS Phase-II enters 30th day

**Money on track** 

South Central Railway (SCR) general manager Mallya Gajanan Wednesday asked for the Telangana government's cooperation with respect to many delayed projects within the zone, including work on the Cherlapally terminal, MMTS Phase 2 and Akkannapet-Medak new line project. He was speaking to media personnel on the Pink Book, the Railway's annual docu ment detailing budgetary allocations to various works that was released

on Wednesday. Mr Mallya announced that the SCR zone had received "substantial" allocation for the year 2020-21. "We have been sanctioned a staggering ₹6,846 crore for this year, out of which ₹1.850 has been earmarked for projects in Telangana. Alloca-tion for projects Telangana has, in fact, increased by nearly 50 per cent from last year," he said.

Around ₹54 crore has been allotted for Akka-nnapet-Medak new line project. "We are almost through

with this project. We need some support from the Telangana state government. The Railways has put in more than its share for the project," he said. Similarly, Mr Mallya said the state government was required to pitch in its share for the MMTS Phase-II project, for which ₹40 crore (out of a total estimate of ₹817 crore) has been sanctioned for 2020-21.

Some "token amounts" have been sanctioned for projects in the state as well.

For instance, the much-awaited Ghatkesar-Yadadri extension (33-km-long) has been given just ₹10 lakh while its total cost is

A senior temple official said that the fraudsters have developed websites with certain key words that are related to TTD, Tirumala, Lord Venka-teowore and Lord Polai teswara and Lord Balaji. "After creating fake websites with these kinds of names, they enlist their websites on various online search portals.

When a devotee enters inappropriate keywords, fake websites appear along with TTD's official websites", he said. "After the TTD online quota for darshan and accommodation gets filled, the official websites of TTD shows 'no vacan-cy' prop ups. Eventually, the devotees' approach other websites, which invariably show darshan and accommodation slots as being vacant. The devotees, who purchase tickets on these fake websites, are denied entry, darshan and accommodation at Tirumala," he explained. ### **HC QUESTIONS RULES TO FERRY** ANIMALS

#### VUJJINI VAMSHIDHARA | DC HYDERABAD, FEB. 5

The Telangana High Court on Wednesday sought answers from the state and Central governments on why there are contradictions in the rules framed by them for the purpose of safe transportation of animals. The bench compris-ing Chief Justice Raghavendra Singh Chauhan and Justice A. Abhishek Reddy was hearing two sepapleas filed rate Confederation of Indian Farmers Associations and All India Jamiatul Quresh Action Committee that questioned the rules and pointed out the contradictions between them. Rule 125 E of the Central Motor Vehicles Rules 1989 was brought in by the Centre in 2015 and notified in 2017 and Rule 253 of the Telangana Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989 has imposed certain restrictions on the transportation of animals. They made it mandatory for farmers to have specified vehicles for the purpose. Small vehicles like tempos etc cannot be used for this purpose. Vehicles transporting animals should not be open-ended. An attendant should be deployed with each such vehicle while transporting the animals and there are restrictions imposed on the number of animals that can be transported in each such vehicle.

Forest officials must stay alert and stop the accident before it happens. Even fire department officials will be on standby to douse any blaze in the forest," said principal chief conservator of forests R. Sobha.

While some fires break out naturally, such as when dry twigs rub against each other due to the wind, there are more anthropogenic reasons for the fires, offianswer nature's call," DFO Nagarkurnool, Mr Joji, told Deccan Chronicle.

Another reason for fires breaking out, he said, was the occasional cigarette lit by tourists, who don't put it out completely. "We have stopped people from collecting beedi leaves. Why?The collection of beedi leaves has been banned, added. Worst of all are those light fires for a video that they can then post on social media, Mr Joji said. The department will now hold educational programmes at check posts aimed at discouraging the careless use of flammable

materials.

Asserting that no foreign country has the right to interfere in the internal matters of India, Rajya Sabha Chairman M Venkaiah Naidu on Wednesday said Indian Parliament is a sovereign authority to discuss and decide on issues related to the country.

Responding to Shiv Sena MP Anil Desai's mention in the Upper House of Parliament to the resolution in the European Parliament against the amended Citizenship Act, the Chairman of the House said that no foreign country has the right to interfere in the internal matters of India and this message should be sent out loud and clear.

Raising the issue in the House during the Zero Hour, Desai suggested that a resolution should be passed that India will not tolerate any interference from other countries in its internal matters.

"I want to make it very clear as Chairman of the House and also as Vice President of the country, whatever issues are there, Indian Parliament is a sovereign authority to discuss and decide...outside countries have no right to interfere in our internal affairs," said Naidu while adding that other countries should take care of their own respective matters.

Six political groups of mem-bers of European Parliament had moved a joint resolution against the CAA, calling it discriminatory.

The European Parliament had, however, decided not to conduct a vote on the resolu-tion during its new session beginning March 2.

# MP becomes 5th state to pass resolution against CAA

Madhya Pradesh cabinet on Wednesday passed a resolution against Citizenship Amendment Act, calling it divisive. Besides, Article 14 of the Constitution grants equality to all citizens of the country under the law," the resolution by the state cabinet read.
