He said coronavirus that dogs and cats commonly arry is not transferable to humans. "There has been vaccine for coronavirus which attacks gastrointestinal system but Covid 19 virus affect the respiratories in dogs and cats are mild, the corona vaccines are considered non-essen-

tial and not routinely rec-ommended. We have been giving such corona vac-cines to stray animals and

many private veterinary doctors have been practis-ing the same for several years," he added.

#### **TIPS TO PETS OWNERS**

• When handling and caring for animals, basic hygiene measures should always be implemented. This includes hand washing before and after being around or handling animals, their food or supplies, as well as avoiding kissing, licking or sharing food.

When possi If they must look If they must look after their pet, they should maintain good hygiene practices and wear a face mask if possible. Animals belonging to owners infected with Covid-19 should be kept indoors as much as possible ble, people who are sick or under medical atten-tion for Covid-19. should avoid close contact with their pets and have anothas much as possible and contact with those pets should be avoided as much as possible. er member of their household care for their animals.

• Currently, there is no evidence that companion animals are playing a signifi-cant epidemiological role in this human disease. However, because animals and people can sometimes share diseases (zoonotic diseases), it is recommended that people with Covid-19 limit contact with companion and other animals until more info is known about the virus.
